

We Samuel C. Gallaher, Henry S. Gallin and Justus C. Hall Citizens of the United States and residents of the State of New York and William H. Bennett, Frank Campbell, Larabett P. Hall and George H. Hall Citizens of the United States and residents of the Territory of Idaho, intending to avail ourselves of the general laws of the said Territory of Idaho, respecting the formation of Corporations or hereby certify and declare

First: That the Corporation to be thus formed shall be known by the name of "The Deer Creek Gold Mining Company".

Second: The object for which it is formed is the acquisition by purchase or otherwise, of gold mines within said Territory, known as Placer mines, and to work them by hydraulic means, or by any device adapted to the separation and retention of gold or other precious metals, from sand or gravel in which it is found; and for this purpose to acquire water rights and privileges, by purchase or otherwise; to build construct maintain and operate canals, ditches,

and Water Works for the purpose of
conducting Water from its Natural
Sources and Channels, to and upon
the property that may be acquired
and generally to do and perform
all things needful and appropriate
to the Special industry for which
the said Corporation is formed.

Third: The Amount of the Capital
Stock of said Corporation shall
and the same is hereby declared
to be One Million Dollars, which
shall be divided into Two Hundred
Thousand Shares of the par value
of Five dollars each.

Fourth: The term of the Existence
of said Corporation shall be fifty
years, from the filing of this Certificate.

Fifth: The number of Trustees
for the management of said Corporation
shall be Seven.

Sixth: The names of the Trustees
who shall manage the affairs for
the first three months, are those
submitted to this Certificate viz:
Samuel C. Gallaher, Henry C.
Gallaher, Justus C. Hall, William
H. Bennett, Frank Canybell

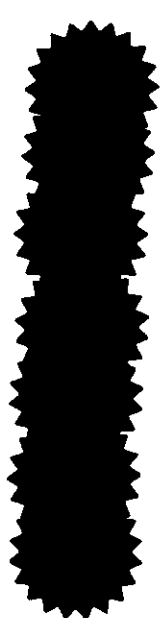

of Idaho
