

#### ARTICLES of INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, having been duly elected Trustees of the Christian Church of Twin Falls, State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purpose of our election, do hereby associate ourselves and the other members of said church, togetherfor the purpose of forming a religious corporation under the following articles:

#### ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be, "First Christian Church of Twin Falls".

#### Article II.

The objects and purposes of this corporation shall be the maintaining of said church, the establishment of other churches and customary
and suitable organizations for public worship, religious training
and the dissemination of the teachings of the Holy Scriptures, and as
incident to said objects and purposes shall have power and authority
to purchase, lease, own, hold, control and improve sufficient real and
personal property upon and from which to construct and maintain
churches, parsonages, schools and other suitable buildings in futherance of said objects and purposes, together with convenient and
suitable grounds, with power to sell, let, convey, exchange and
mortgage said prperty and to execute notes and other contracts for
the purchase, building, maintaing, improving and careing for the same

### ARTICLE III.

The principal place for the transaction of the business of this corporation shall be Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

### ARTICLE IV.

The corporation shall exist for a period of Fifty years.

### ARTICLE V.

The number of the trustees of this corporation shall be three.

# ARTICLE VI.

The Trustees of said corporation shall be elected annually on the first Monday after the first Sunday in January and shall hold their respective offices for one year after said time or until their

successors are duly elected and qualified and until the first election and qualification D. W. Brunk, B. A. Vammeter and W. G. Trublood shall constitute the Board of Trustees, and until such time said Board may be convened at any time with the consent of any two members upon the call of the Secretary of such Board, and until such time D.W. Brunk shall be President, B. A. Vammeter Secretary and W. G. Trublood Treasurer, respectively of such Board.

ARTICLE VII.

Any member of said church shall be a member of this corporation.

ARTICLES VIII.

These articles of incorporation may be amended by a vote of the majority of the members of this corporation at any annual meeting and at any special meeting called for that purpose.

## ARTICLE IX.

was held at the church building of said church in Twin Falls, State Idaho on the 4 day of Jack , 1909 At said meeting a majority of the members of said church were present and voted at said meeting and at said time D. W. Brunk, B. A. Vanmeter and W. Trublood were elected Trustees.
