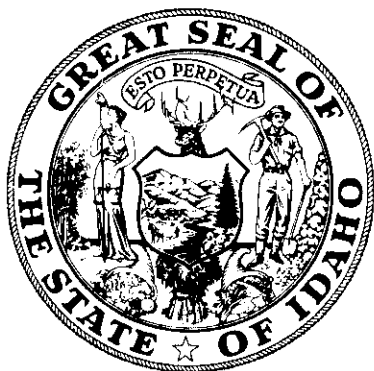

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FUNDAMENTAL BAPTIST CHURCH, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT, that we CLINTON R. KEATON, DOROTHY L. KEATON, PAUL S. COX, MARGARETTE COX, MARK E. LINDSAY, KELLY BRIANS, VIRGINIA M COREY, TODD COREY, IRMA GRIGGS, JOHN WYATT, BRIAN E. NEWTON, LINDA A NEWTON, DAN CONNOLLY, MARY R. M. HAYWARD, ALL OF WHOM ARE OF LEGAL AGE, AND HAVE THIS DAY VOLUNTARILY ASSOCIATED OURSELVES TOGETHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF FORMING A NON-PROFIT RELIGIOUS CORPORATION, UNDER AND PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 11, TITLE 30, IDAHO CODE, DO HEREBY CERTIFY AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of this corporation shall be FUNDAMENTAL BAPTIST CHURCH, INC., and the principal place of business and mailing address is ^{128 West C Street} ~~P. O. Box 8482~~, Moscow, Idaho. *Registered Agent is Clinton R. Keaton, 128 West C Street Moscow, Id.*

ARTICLE II.

The duration and existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit or gain. There shall be no stock. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensations for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation shall have the management vested in the Board of Directors which shall consist of not less than three (3) nor more than fifteen (15) members.

ARTICLE V.

The purpose of this corporation shall be to form the nucleus of a fundamental, evangelistic and disciple-making church dedicated to the bringing of others to the knowledge and full maturity in Jesus Christ and the training of disciples to carry out these concepts, and to do all the acts permitted by the general business corporation law of Idaho and all such legal acts as are necessary and expedient to accomplish these stated purposes.

ARTICLE VI.

Pursuant to Section 30-1102 of the Idaho Code, and election of the Directors of this organization was held on November 3, 1981, at 8:00 P. M., at Fundamental Baptist Church, 128 West C Street, Moscow, Idaho, at which election a majority of the members present voted. Notice of said election was given as required in Section 30-1102 of the Idaho Code.

By a majority vote the following were elected to be Directors of this organization:

JOHN WYATT, P. O. BOX 8865, MOSCOW, IDAHO

MARK LINDSAY, 745 NEZ PERCE, MOSCOW, IDAHO

ARTICLE VII.

That all of the Incorporators subscribed hereto are of full age and are citizens of the United States.

ARTICLE VIII.

This corporation shall have in addition to powers conferred by the statutes of the State of Idaho, the power to lease, purchase, hold and sell or convey property and to enter into any business transaction necessary for corporation purposes.

ARTICLE IX.

OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS of this organization shall be elected by the members at the annual meeting pursuant to the requirements set forth in the By-Laws. The number of officers and directors shall be designated in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE X.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law,) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
