ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT MOUNT ZION UNIVERSITIES CHURCH OF PENCOSTER INCORPORATED

This is in Response, To the Amendment, To Change The Misspelled word, In The Heading of the Corporation, To Proper, Which That of "MOUNT ZION UNIVERSITY CHURCH OF PENTACOSTAL, INCORPORATED.

Into The CorporationArticle, As Corrected Spelling, To The Existing Provisions.

"Notwithstanding Any Other Provions Of These Articles, The Corporation Shall Not Carry On Any Other Activities NOt Permitted To Be Carried On (a) by A Corpoation Exempt From Federal Income Tax Under Section 501(c) (3) Of The Internal RevenueCode of 1986 (Or the corresponding provisions of any future United StatesInternal Revenue Law.)
Or (b) By a Corporation Contibutions to which are Deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of The Internal Revenue Codeof 1986. (or Corresponding Provionsof any future Nnited States Internal Revenue Law.)".

"Upon the Dissolution of this Corpoation, assets shall be distibuted for one or more exempt purposes with in the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (orcorresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code.) or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a State or local Government, For a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed by the court of common pleas of the county in which the principle office of the corpoation is then located, exclusivly for such purposes or to such organizations or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusivly for such purposes."
