Article 2

Zero Dark Thirty Coffee Foundation Inc is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 3

The business activity for Zero Dark Thirty Coffee Foundation Inc. is as follows: Money will be given to the foundation from Zero Dark Thirty Coffee LLC to be distributed to legitimate 501c3 charities focused on helping American Veterans and first responders recover from mental and physical injuries sustained in service. The foundation will also raise money through fundraising and grants for the same purpose. In the future, the foundation will have the ability to disburse funds directly to Veterans and first responders from Idaho who are suffering from the same type of injuries.

Article 7

The period of duration of this corporation is: as long as the corporation is self sufficient and can continue to benefit the veteran and first responder community.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)2 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
