

SPECIAL MEETING OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SUBJECT OF

NOTIFICATION
The Board of County Commissioners met this day in a special meeting pursuant to their
regular meeting on Wednesday, July 26, 1950, with Chairman, Arnfred Christensen, Commissioners,
W. P. Judge and Clerk, V. P. Wootton being present when the following
matters came up for consideration:

WHEREAS THE MATTER OF THE INCORPORATION OF THE ATOMIC CITY.

WHEREAS A Resolution regarding the Incorporation of the Atomic City was moved by Walter C. Bithell, and seconded by W. P. Judge to be allowed. The following Order was adopted unanimously.

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BINGHAM COUNTY, IDAHO.

IN THE MATTER OF THE INCORPORATION : ORDER OF INCORPORATION.
OF THE VILLAGE OF ATOMIC CITY :

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed with and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Bingham County, Idaho, a Petition, signed by ninety-nine (99) actual residents upon the real property described in the Petition, and said petitioners praying that they be incorporated as a village under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in which Petition they designate "Atomic City, Idaho" as the name they wish to assume, and describe with particularity the territory to be included therein by metes and bounds; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board upon consideration of said Petition that there are more than one hundred twenty-five (125) actual residents residing within the territory described in said Petition, and that more than a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the said territory therein described signed said Petition, and that said Petition is in all respects true and correct, and in full conformity with statutory requirements; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the prayer of said Petition should, and ought, to be granted;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That there be, and there is hereby created, established and incorporated, a village within the County of Bingham, State of Idaho, which is comprised of territory lying and being situate within said county, and which is more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the South $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 31 E.W.M., thence East 633 feet, thence North 30°11' West, parallel with the State Highway 3014 feet to the East center line of Section 3, thence West 1930 feet to the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section, thence South 160 rods to the Southwest corner of said section 3, thence East 160 feet to the point of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the name by which said village shall be known and designated is, and shall be, Atomic City, Idaho, and that said Village of Atomic City, Idaho, from the date hereof, shall have all the rights, powers and immunities provided by the laws of the State of Idaho, and shall be governed by the provisions of said laws applicable to the government of villages.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That J. B. Weise, Quentin Packrell, Marjorie Packrell, J. H. Bartholomew and D. B. Yancey, persons possessing the qualifications required by Section 40-703 of the Idaho Code, be, and they are hereby, appointed as trustees of said Atomic City, Idaho, to hold office until their successors are elected and qualified, in the time, manner and form prescribed by the statutes of the State of Idaho.
