ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
STOCKING LAND AND LIVESTOCK, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. L. STOCKING, LUCY STOCKING and WALLACE STOCKING, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, of legal age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of incorporation and hereby incorporate under, and conformable to, the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby make, execute, adopt, publish and certify the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be:

STOCKING LAND AND LIVESTOCK, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) To acquire farm and ranch property and other real estate by purchase, lease or otherwise, and to improve and develop the same and thereon to plant, sow, cultivate and harvest grain, hay, forage, vegetables, fruits, and all kinds of farm produce and products of the soil; to breed, raise, buy, pasture, prepare for market, exchange, sell and deal in livestock of all kinds; to engage in dairy, poultry, and market gardening business; to acquire and maintain shops, stalls, market stands, delivery vehicles and all other conveyances and equipment suitable for carrying on and conducting the general business of farming and ranching and in general to conduct in all their several departments and engage in and carry on the business of farming, ranching, fruit growing, stock raising, dairying, and to do everything incidental or conducive to the full accomplishment thereof.

(b) To buy, sell, trade and deal in all kinds of agricultural and livestock products at wholesale and retail.

(c) To feed and slaughter cattle, hogs, sheep and other livestock, and to buy and sell the same as principal or agent.

(d) To purchase or otherwise acquire and own, hold, lease, sell, exchange, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of and to invest, trade and deal in and with real and personal property of every kind and description and any and all interests therein.

(e) To borrow money, to issue bonds, debentures, notes, mortgages, and other obligations of the corporation from time to time for any of the objects of the corporation, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and/or convey in trust any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

(f) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind for every lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, or any subdivision, district or department thereof.

(g) To provide dwelling houses for its employees and others for the use and residence of its employees, agents and officers.

(h) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incident, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, directly or indirectly; to promote the interest of the corporation and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers which a natural person could do or exercise and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law; and to conduct its business in this state, other states, the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries.

(i) The several clauses contained in the statement of purposes shall be considered and construed as both purposes and powers, and the statement contained in each clause shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers and no recitation or declaration of specific or specified powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

ARTICLE III

The duration of the existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the corporation's registered office shall be Carey, Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The capital of this corporation shall consist of \$50,000.00, consisting of 50,000 shares of the par value of \$1.00 per share, and this stock shall be the only class of capital stock of the corporation; and stock may be issued by said corporation from time to time for such consideration for labor, services, money or property as may be fixed by resolution from time to time by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI

The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall consist of three members; said Board of Directors may be increased by resolution of the stockholders of this corporation at any meeting regularly assembled.

ARTICLE VII

The By-Laws to be adopted by the corporation may be amended, repealed or new By-Laws added by a vote of two-thirds of the directors.

ARTICLE VIII

The names and post office addresses of each of the Incorporators of the corporation and a statement of the number of shares subscribed is as follows:

ARTICLE IX

The corporation shall have the power to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold and reissue its own stock and to buy, acquire, deal in and transfer shares of capital stock, bonds, debentures and other securities issued or created by any other corporation, cooperative, marketing or purchasing association.
