We, the undersigned committee, do hereby certify as follows: A notice of the meeting to incorporate, was duly given and such meeting was held in accordance therewith on the 8th day of May 1958, 8 o'clock P.M. on said day.

William S. Green was the presiding officer of such meeting. At such meeting, it was determined to incorporate such congregation in pursuance to the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE NO. 1- NAME

The name of the proposed corporation as decided on at such meeting is, Blanchard Community Church, Inc.

ARTICLE NO. 2- LOCATION

The principal place of worship of such congregation is to be located in Blanchard, County of Bonner, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE NO. 3- DURATION

The term of the incorporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE NO. 4- PURPOSE

And we certify, that the objects for which this corporation is formed are: To establish a Church organization in Blanchard, Bonner County, Idaho, and in connection therewith suitable and customary organizations, for the purpose of Religious, Charitable, and educational purposes to advance the Kingdom of God among men. Its doctrines and customs and practices are expected to harmonize with the standard of God's Word.

To establish and maintain a place of worship and to build, buy, sell, own, mortgage, lease, or other wise hold and dispose of real and personal property necessary to properly establish, and maintain a place a worship.

ARTICLE NO. 5- TRUSTEES

The number of trustees decided on at such meeting was five (5). The name of the trustees elected at such meeting to hold office untill the first annual election are respectively as follows:
