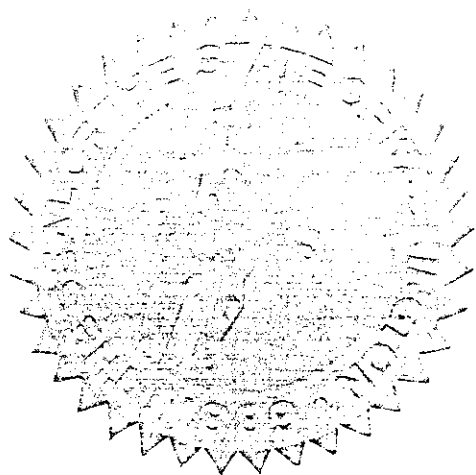

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
SIME CONSTRUCTION CO.  
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, A. R. SIME, IRVING  
A. SIME, and JAMES A. SIME, being each of full age and a citizen of the United  
States have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a  
corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and in pursuance thereof  
do hereby sign and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation in  
triplicate originals and do state as follows:

I

That the corporate name of this corporation shall be SIME CONSTRUCTION

CO.

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (A) To purchase, apply for, receive, sell, transfer, give, encumber, mortgage, hypothecate, and otherwise deal in and with franchises, easements, rights, privileges, licenses, trademarks, trade names, patents, inventions, improvements, and processes, and to purchase, lease from others and otherwise dispose of, mortgage or otherwise hypothecate or encumber any and all types of real property and each and every kind of personal property.
- (B) To manufacture, construct, build, repair, make, rebuild, develop, and erect any and all types of structures, roads, ditches, wells, tunnels, bridges, wharves, mining, claims, gravel pits, quarry pits, sand pits, and all things of whatsoever kind related to the general contracting business and to generally contract for and agree to perform any and all types of construction work.
- (C) To manufacture, buy, sell, transfer, hypothecate, mortgage, pledge, and generally deal in machinery of any and all kinds and such mechanical devices and appliances as may now or hereafter be manufactured and to distribute to retailers, customers, or wholesalers, and generally deal with any and all types of property in any manner whatsoever.
- (D) To loan or borrow money on all types of real or personal property and to give or receive security on all types of real or personal property therefor.
- (E) To buy, sell, loan, pledge, hypothecate, receive, and to generally deal with any and all types of common stock or bonds issued by any private or public corporation.
- (F) This corporation shall have the capacity to act the same as that possessed by a natural person. In addition to the foregoing powers enumerated, it shall have the power and authority to transact and carry on all other businesses and activities the same as a natural person with the general powers conferred under corporations by the

laws relating thereto. It shall have authority to perform all such actions that are necessary to accomplish its purposes and which are not in conflict with the law.

### III

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

### IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation shall be 16 So. Quillian, Kennedick, Washington.

### V

The stock of this corporation shall be all of one class known as

common stock, having all the privileges, voting rights, and powers generally of a share of a corporation. The stock shall be five hundred (500) shares in

number, each share having a par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars. The

total authorized stock issue of this corporation shall be Fifty Thousand

(\$50,000.00) Dollars.

### VI

The amount of paid in capital with which this corporation shall be-  
gin business is the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars.

### VII

That the directors of this corporation shall be three in number and the qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers and duties of the directors shall be such as are prescribed by the by-laws of this corporation.
