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EXHIBIT A TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF
BALLET SUN VALLEY, INC.

Article 2. The Purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively for Charitable, Educational and Literary purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time.

The corporation is to accomplish its purposes by (a) promoting interest in the study of the arts, drama and dance in particular; (b) advancing knowledge and appreciation of drama and dance, and classical, artistic, musical, literary and social tradition by dance and theatrical performances or by other appropriate means; (c) providing and supporting facilities for the education, instruction and performance of dance and theater; and supporting the development of ballet so its benefits may inure to the American people and, particularly the people of Idaho.

No part of the corporation's income is to be devoted to other than charitable, educational or literary uses or purposes. No part of net earnings or assets of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article 2.
