ARTICLES OF DESIGNATION OF REGISTERED OFFICE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we Wellman Clark, President and Gladyce Colburn, Secretary of YREKA MINING COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the provisions of the Business Corporation Act of the State of Idaho

DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

That the holders and owners present at a meeting of the corporation held in Spokane, Washington on the 28th day of December, 1955 unanimously consented and authorized a change in the registered office from Kellogg, Idaho to 517 Idaho Building, Boise, Idaho, and in furtherance thereof, the change in Articles of Incorporation so that Article IV thereof is amended to read as follows:
