HOMEDALE ROD AND GUN CLUB, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **twenty-seventh** day of **April** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **fifty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **69** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 29-103 and Sections 29-1001 to 29-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code, Annotated.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Homedale** in the County of **Owyhee** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations, as provided in Chapter 10, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

1 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

2 OF

3 HOMEDALE ROD AND GUN CLUB, INC.

4 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, each
5 being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States
6 of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes herein-
7 after stated, pursuant to the corporation laws of the State of Idaho,
8 do hereby execute and adopt these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, and we
9 do hereby certify as follows, to-wit:

10 ARTICLE I

11 The name of this corporation is, and shall be: "HOMEDALE ROD
12 AND GUN CLUB, INC."

13 ARTICLE II

14 The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as
15 follows:

16 a. To promote and instruct rifle and pistol practice and
17 activities.

18 b. To cooperate and affiliate with the National Rifle Associ-
19 ation of America.

20 c. To own, operate and maintain both indoor and outdoor rifle
21 pistol ranges, trap and skeet fields, for the shooting of all
22 calibers and gauges of rifles, pistols and shot guns.

23 d. To encourage the use of rifles and pistols, train and instruct
24 membership in the use of all kinds of firearms, and to foster legis-
25 lation against any unsound anti-gun law that would be detrimental to
26 any sportsman or honest gun owner.

27 e. To foster, perpetuate and promote activities for the preser-
28 vation of wild life and fish in the State of Idaho.

29 f. To own, operate, maintain and control bird refuges, hatch-
30 eries, pens and equipment for the care and proagation of wild life.

31 g. To maintain, operate and own fish hatcheries and rearing
32 ponds for the hatching and propagation of all types of game and food
33 fishes.

34 h. To cooperaté with all public and private agencies for the
35 furtherance and developement of fish and game in the State of Idaho

1 wherein said cooperation is for public good;

2 i. To print and publish magazines and literature advertising
3 shooting activities, wild life and game fish in the State of Idaho;

4 j. To purchase and receive as gifts, ammunition, guns, targets,
5 and shooting supplies, hunting equipment of all kinds and nature,
6 boats, canoes, motors, hunting and fishing clothing and equipment for
7 and on behalf of members of this corporation in good standing;

8 k. To maintain and build camp and hire personel and guides
9 necessary in the operation thereof for and on behalf of the members
10 of good standing in this corporation.

11 l. To pperate and maintain on behalf of the club benefits and
12 entertainment for the purpose of raising funds for the furthering
13 of the purposes herein;

14 m. To organize maintain and support junior rifle clubs and fish
15 and game leagues;

16 n. To own and possess by purchase or lease suitable building or
17 buildings for club quarters, and to equip and provided said club
18 building or buildings with such equipment libraries and supplies as
19 may be necessary to the furtherance of the purposes hereof;

20 o. To own and operate such trucks, automobiles, and motor
21 vehicles as may be required for the operation under the purposes of
22 this corporation;

23 p. To receive donations of both real and personal property,
24 and to do all and every thing incident to the betterment of shooting
25 game, wild life, and fish for the sportsman of the State of Idaho and
26 the United States all subject to the laws of the State of Idaho and
27 the United States of America;

28 ARTICLE III

29 This corporation is to have perpetual existence.

30 ARTICLE IV

31 The location and postoffice address of the registered office
32 of this corporation is Homedale, County of Owyhee, Idaho.

33 ARTICLE V

34 This corporation shall be a cooperative association organized
35 not for profit and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared
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1 to the membership of this corporation.

2 ARTICLE VI

3 The right and interest of all members of this corporation shall
4 be equal and no member can have or acquire a greater interest in this
5 corporation than any other member and this corporation shall not
6 issue any captial stock, but shall issue membership certificates to
7 each member, which certificates can not be assigned so that the
8 transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of this
9 corporation.

10 ARTICLE VII

11 The membership of this corporation shall consist of all persons
12 of good character and repute over the age of 18 years who are willing
13 to subscribed to the objects of this corporation subject to such
14 further requirements as may be established by the by-laws of this
15 corporation.

16 ARTICLE VIII

17 The names and postoffice addresseof each of the incorporators
18 of this corporation, all of whom are over the age of majority, are
19 citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho and have
20 subscribed for a membership in this corporation, is as follows:
