STATE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

M & M SUPPLY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all citizens of the United States of legal age, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and

WE CERTIFY:

FIRST

That the name of this corporation is M & M SUPPLY, INC.

SECOND

That the nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried on are to do any and all of the things herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world, viz:

(a) To engage in any commercial, industrial and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the state of Idaho; to generally engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform.

(b) To buy, manufacture, or otherwise acquire, and to sell, distribute or otherwise dispose of, either at retail or wholesale, lumber, hardware, building materials, building equipment, tools, and supplies of every kind and character; to establish and maintain stores, yards, plants, warehouses, mills, and other distributing and manufacturing centers for the manufacture, assembling, and distributing of any and every kind of commodity, goods, wares, merchandise, or other article of trade or commerce.

(c) To acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise and to improve and develop real property. To erect dwellings, apartment houses and other buildings, private or public, of all kinds, and

to sell or rent the same.

(d) To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for and incident to the accomplishment of the purposes enumerated above, and for the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers, or any part or parts thereof, provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is granted.

IN FURTHERANCE AND NOT IN LIMITATION Of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho, and of the objects and purposes herein set forth, it is expressly provided that this corporation shall also have the following powers, viz:

(a) To borrow or loan money with or without security therefor; to issue promissory notes, bonds, debentures, mortgages, security agreements of all kinds, and other evidences of indebtedness.

(b) To make, enter into and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, body politic, county, state or the federal government.

(c) To have one or more offices to conduct its business and promote its objects within and without the State of Idaho, in other states and territories of the United States, or other countries, subject, however, to the laws and limitations of such state, territory or country; and to maintain divisions, branches, or companies under other names although wholly owned by this corporation.

(d) To purchase or otherwise acquire, lease, assign, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any trade names, trade marks, concessions, inventions, formulas, improvements, processes of any nature whatsoever, copyrights and letters patent of the United States and foreign countries.

THIRD

That the existence of this corporation is to be perpetual after its incorporation, unless sooner dissolved or disincorporated pursuant to law.

FOURTH

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted and the registered office of the corporation in this State shall be at 75 West Little Avenue, Driggs, Teton County, Idaho 83422.

FIFTH

That the total authorized capital of this corporation shall be \$20,000.00, divided into 2,000 shares with a par value of \$10.00 per share. All stock shall be common stock and when fully paid shall be non-assessable and not subject to call. Each share of stock shall be entitled to one vote.

The corporation shall have the power to adopt, by appropriate by-laws, a provision or provisions restricting the sale or transfer of shares of stock; provided that the same shall be in accordance with applicable laws.

SIXTH

That the amount of the capital stock which has been actually subscribed and paid for is the sum of 1,000 shares, and following are the names of the persons, their addresses and the number of shares by whom the same have been subscribed, to-wit:

The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the stockholders, to be held at the general office of the corporation in said Driggs, Idaho 83422, unless at a different place designated by the board of directors, at a time in each year, to be designated by the by-laws, and until such election, the directors of said corporation shall be: George Madsen, President; S. M. Meikle, Vice President; Janice Meikle, Secretary; and Blanche Madsen, Treasurer.

EIGHTH

The by-laws of this corporation may be adopted by the shareholders in the manner provided for by the laws of the State of Idaho.
