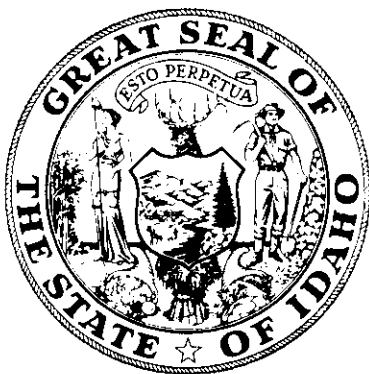

ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

PURSUANT TO SECTION 92 OF THE
IDAHO BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 92 of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, the undersigned Association adopts the following Articles of Dissolution for the purpose of dissolving the Professional Association:

FIFTH: All remaining property and assets of the Association have been distributed among its shareholders, in accordance with their respective rights and interests.

SIXTH: There are no suits pending against the Association in any court in respect of which adequate provision has

been made for the satisfaction of any judgment, order of decree which may be entered against it.

SEVENTH: The dissolution has received the unanimous written consent of the shareholders of the Association and is to be accomplished pursuant to a Resolution to Dissolve adopted in the manner required by Section 30-1-84 of the Idaho Code.

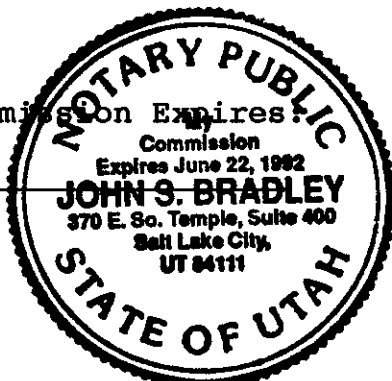
