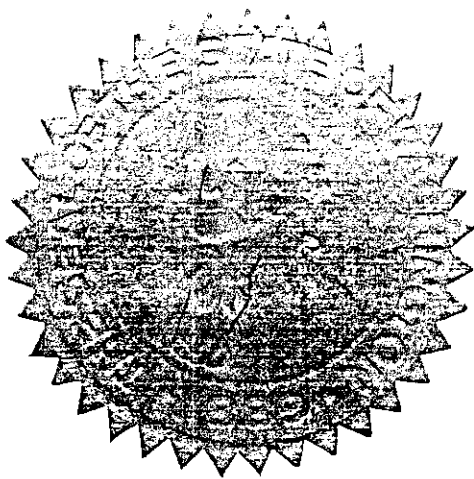

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

6 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned,
7 each being a citizen of the United States and a resident of the
8 State of Washington, and being over the age of twenty-one years
9 and desirous of forming a corporation for the objects and purposes
10 hereinafter specified and set forth, do hereby associate ourselves
11 together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by
12 virtue of the laws of the State of Washington relating to private
13 corporations, and do make, subscribe, execute, and acknowledge in
14 triplicate, these, the Articles of Incorporation thereof.

15 **ARTICLE I**

16 **CORPORATE NAME**

17 The corporate name of this corporation shall be "PAUL
18 JARVIS, INC."

19 **ARTICLE II**

20 **OBJECTS**

21 The objects and purposes for which this corporation is
22 formed shall be as follows:

23 1. To carry on a general contracting business of every kind
24 and nature whatsoever in the United States and Canada.

25 2. This corporation shall have power to purchase, take,
26 acquire, appropriate, condemn, accept, hold, enjoy, lease, rent,
27 possess, sell and dispose of any and all real and personal property,
28 and any and every interest and estate therein, which it shall deem
29 desirable, useful, necessary or convenient in connection with its
30 notes, choses in action, bonds, mortgages, and other securities,
and including the capital stock of other corporations.

1 3. To sell, lease, rent, dispose of, grant, convey, transfer,
2 pledge, encumber, and mortgage at any time all or any of the real
3 or personal property, and any estate or interest therein.

4 4. To borrow money, contract debts, make contracts and
5 agreements, and assume, guarantee and pledge itself to pay, dis-
6 charge and perform any debt, contract, or obligation of any other
7 person, firm, company, association, or corporation.

8 5. To make, execute, and deliver promissory notes and
9 choses in action.

10 6. To make, execute, issue, and sell and to issue in purchase
11 of property negotiable coupon bonds, and for the purpose of secur-
12 ing the payment or performance of any promissory note, bond,
13 contract, debt, or obligation made, issued, assumed, or guaranteed
14 by this corporation, to make, execute, and deliver mortgages, deeds
15 of trust, pledges and hypothecations of and upon all or any of its
16 real and personal property, including after acquired property.

17 7. To loan and invest any of its moneys or funds.

18 8. To take, own, hold, collect, and enforce promissory
19 notes, choses in action, contracts, bonds, mortgages, and
20 securities, and to sell, transfer, and dispose of the same.

21 9. To subscribe for, purchase, take, own, hold, sell, trans-
22 fer and dispose of shares of the capital stock of any other company
23 or corporation, and be a stockholder in any other corporation.

24 10. In general to do and perform any and all things and acts
25 which are germane to or which will tend to aid and accomplish the
26 purpose of its incorporation, or promote its interest.

27 ARTICLE III

28 DURATION

29 The duration of this corporation and the time of its
30 existence shall be fifty (50) years.

ARTICLE IV

LOCATION

The post office address of this corporation shall be 3951 - 6th Avenue, N.W., Seattle 7, Washington.

ARTICLE V

STOCK

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of Two thousand (2000) shares of the par value of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share.

The amount of paid-in capital with which the corporation will begin business is Seventy-five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

POWER TO INCREASE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The stockholders of the corporation, by a majority vote, may at any time increase the number of directors of this corporation to any number not exceeding seven (7).

ARTICLE VIII

COMMENCEMENT OF BUSINESS

The directors herein named and appointed to manage the affairs of this corporation until the first day of July 1, 1945, or any one of them designated by a majority of said directors, are hereby constituted, appointed, and authorized to open books and secure subscriptions to the capital stock of this corporation.

ARTICLE IX

BY-LAWS

The stockholders of this corporation shall, at their first meeting, or at any subsequent meeting, adopt and provide by-laws for the general guidance of the company's officers, for the regulation and management of its property and business, regulating the issuance and transfer of shares of the capital stock, for the election and appointment of such officers and agents as shall be deemed necessary for the corporation, and fixing and prescribing their duties and compensation, regulating the making of dividends and concerning other matters relating to the corporation, its property, business, and officers, and providing how such by-laws may be altered, changed, or amended.

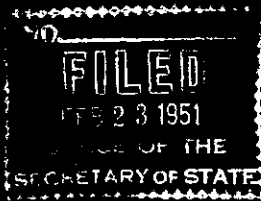
