ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this Association shall be: Mountain Home Police Association Inc.

ARTICLE II – PURPOSE

The purpose of the Mountain Home Police Association is to preserve and strengthen fellowship among its members; to promote and support community based organizations that provide educational opportunities for the youth of our city; to promote benevolent, educational, charitable, civic, patriotic and fraternal activities among the members; to encourage adherence of all employees to high professional standards of conduct and code of police ethics; to promote community relations and support as a voice of and resource for police professionals within the Mountain Home Police Department and Mountain Home Animal Shelter.

ARTICLE ~~II~~ – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Definition of Membership

Active Member: Any dues paying part-time or full-time sworn police officer with the rank of Sergeant and below or civilian employee of the Mountain Home Police Department or Mountain Home Animal Shelter, including any employee who may be under suspension or disciplinary appeal, or unpaid leave status (i.e.: disability, military leave, etc.), provided such member keeps his or her dues current through a written promise. Active members may hold any elected office, serve on any standing or ad hoc committee, and vote on any issue before the membership, provided they are not in unfavorable standing. Active members will receive all benefits of the Association. Respectfully, in order to prevent any conflicts of interest or undue influence the Chief of Police may not be a member of the Mountain Home Police Association.

Associate Member: Any dues paying Lieutenant or Reserve Officer of the Mountain Home Police Department, including any officer who may be under suspension or disciplinary appeal, provided such member keeps his or her dues current through a written promise. Associate members may serve on any standing or ad hoc committee and vote on any issue before the membership, provided they are not in unfavorable standing. Associate members may not hold any elected office. Associate members will receive all benefits of the Association, with the exception of member loans.
