#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESETNS: That we, the undersigned, all residents of the State of Idaho, natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and organizing a non-profit, benevolent and charitable organization under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 11, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation of said association, and we do hereby certify:

#### ARTICLE I

### NAME

That the name of this corporation is: COLLEGE OF IDAHO CAJOTA CLUB, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

## PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation is a non-profit organization and is formed for benevolent and charitable purposes and especially as follows:

To encourage, promote and engage in athletics, sports, amusements, and activities beneficial to health and to promote, conduct, hold, and arrange such athletic and sporting events, exhibitions, matches and competitions. To offer, grant and contribute toward the provisions of prizes, awards and distinctions. To provide athletic grounds, stands and facilities. To further promote the general athletic and educational interests of the College of Idaho, Caldwell, Idaho. To provide meals, refreshments and other services in connection with sporting and athletic events. To buy, sell, own, lease and improve real estate and personal property which may be required or deemed necessary for the purposes of carrying on any of the objects of the corporation. To contract debts, issue bills, notes, mortgages, bonds, debentures deemed necessary for the purpose of carrying on the objects of the corporation. To devote any and all net proceeds received by said corporation, to charitable, social, civic, fraternal, or patriotic, benevolent or athletic uses and purposes.

#### ARTICLE III

#### PLACE OF BUSINESS

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho, shall be Box 292, Galdwell, Idaho.

#### CAPITAL STOCK
