ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and being citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purpose hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Business Corporations Act of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

That the name of the Corporation is: O. G. MYLER and SONS, INC.

The purposes and objectives of the Corpor-SECTION 1: 11 ation are to purchase, own and operate agricultural lands, buy and 12 sell livestock and carry on a general ranching operation, including 13 but not limited to the following:

- To buy, receive, use, lease, mortgage, sell or other 15 wise deal with, in or on behalf of all types of personal and real 16 property.
- To carry on activities necessary for the promotion of 17 b) 18 the said business.
- To purchase, acquire, errect and construct or make 19 c) 20 improvements upon land, or to buildings, for use for this Corporation 21 for rental or for sale.
- To negotiate for and to enter into all types of con-22 d) 23 tracts with individuals, partnerships, other corporations, or as 24 otherwise necessary and proper to conduct its business.
- To borrow money and to contract debts, when necessary 25 e)

1 for the transaction of its business, or for the exercise of its Corporate rights, privileges, or franchises, or for any other lawful 3 purpose of this corporation. To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute, underwrite and issue Promissory Notes, Bills of Exchange, Warranties, Bonds, debentures and other negotiable or transferrable instruments, or other obligations of the Corporation, payable at specific time or times or payable on the happening of a specific event or events. 9 To acquire, hold, sell or otherwise dispose of shares 10 of stock, debentures, bonds, contracts or obligations, securities, and other evidences of indebtedness of this or any other person or 12 corporation, and to sell, discount, pledge, hypothecate and otherwise dispose of any and all such property. 14 To carry on any and all type of business and ventures 15 as may be lawful under the laws of the State of Idaho. 16 17 This Corporation is to have perpetual existence. 18 19 The location and Post Office address of the registered 20 office of the Corporation is Pocatello, Bannock County, Idaho, but it may also carry on its business elsewhere in the State of Idaho or 22 in any other State of the United States, or elsewhere. 23 24 The total authorized shares of stock is 1,000 shares 25 of common stock with a par value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) 26 per share with an aggregate par value of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS 27 (\$100,000.00). 28 VT 29 A total number of shares subscribed to is ONE THOUSAND 30 (1,000) shares. OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

- The Officers of the Corporation shall Officers. consist of the President, Vice-President and Secretary-treasurer, and such other officers, agents and committees as the Board of Directors may designate, who shall perform such duties and have such authority as usually pertains to such officers in similar corporations, and as may be permitted by the Board of Directors from time to time; providing, that the same person may hold both the office of a Director and a position as a Corporate Officer at the same time.
- Qualification of Officers. The qualifications of the officers shall be determined by the Board of Directors, and as set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation.
- Directors of the Corporation. The Corporation shall C) have the number of Directors as the Board of Directors from time to time desires, but not less than three (3).
- Election of Directors. Directors shall be elected D) by a ballot of the common stock at the annual meeting of the Stockholders and the persons receiving the highest number of votes, shal:

be declared to be elected. Cumulative voting shall not be permitted Within 15 days after election, the Directors shall meet together and elect the officers.

- Resignation of Directors. Any Director may resign by filing his written resignation with the Secretary of the Corporation, or in the case of the resignation of the Secretary, with the President, and upon acceptance thereof by the Board of Directors, the resignation shall become in effect. In case the Board of Directors shall neglect to act upon a submitted resignation within 14 days after its receipt, the resignation shall become effective and the office deemed vacant.
- Removal of Directors. Any Director of the Corporation may be removed at any time in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Idaho for the removal of Directors, or by a vote of the majority of the outstanding common stock of the corporation at any meeting of the common stockholders called for that purpose. A majority of the Directors may adopt By-Laws for the Corporation and may amend and repeal the same from time to time as the Directors may deem necessary and proper.
