ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

RECORD

SAWTOOTH PACIFIC, INC.

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WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, Being one or more natural persons of full age, who are citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho and, to that end, hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Sawtooth Pacific, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed are:

A. To engage in, operate, conduct, manage, maintain and carry on a transportation, trucking and hauling business, in intrastate and interstate, by motor vehicle of every type, name or nature.

B. To conduct business in this state, other states, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and in foreign countries and to have one or more offices and places of business out of this state; and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of and/or convey real or personal property situate within or without the State of Idaho.

C. To buy, sell, lease or otherwise acquire or dispose permits of every kind an nature as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the corporation.

D. To have, exercise and enjoy all of the powers now or hereafter granted to corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho and, particularly, all the powers and privileges granted to corporations by Chapter 1, Title 30, Idaho Code, and any present and/or future amendments thereto; and to do any act or thing necessary or convenient for the transaction of the business of the corporation and/or carrying into effect any and all of the objects and purposes of this corporation.

E. All of the foregoing provisions of this Article are to be construed both as objects and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that the enumeration herein of specific objects and powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business or to exercise any power or to do any act which corporations formed under the laws of Idaho nor or hereafter existing, that at the time may not lawfully carry on or do. It is the intention that the purposes, objects and powers specified in each of the paragraphs of these Articles of Incorporation shall, except as otherwise provided, in no wise be limited to or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of this Article or any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation; and it is the intention that the purposes, objects and powers specified in these Articles of Incorporation shall be regarded as independent purposes, objects and powers.

ARTICLE III

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location of the registered office is HC 63, ~~Box 1735, Challis;~~
the Post Office address of the corporation shall be in the City of
Challis, County of Custer, State of Idaho, at P.O. Box 1008; and
the registered agent is Steve Long of said address. ⁸³²²⁶

ARTICLE V

the stock of the corporation shall be entitled capital stock
having both voting rights and rights of ownership on equal basis
per share. The amount of the authorized capital stock of this
corporation shall be 50,000 shares of no par value except as may be
otherwise agreed in writing by all of the stockholders. Before any
of the capital stock of this corporation may be sold or transferred
by any of its members or shareholders, the corporation itself must
be given a thirty-day (30) written option to repurchase the stock;
provided, however, that should the corporation desire not to
repurchase any stock to be sold or transferred, the remaining
shareholders of the corporation shall be given a thirty-day (30)
written option to purchase said stock after receiving notice, in
writing, that the corporation will not repurchase said stock
itself. The capital stock of this corporation may be exchanged by
the corporation through the Board of Directors for stock in other
corporations.

ARTICLE VI

The amount of the capital stock which has been subscribed and paid for is the sum of three (3) shares, and following are the names of the persons, their addresses and number of shares by whom the same have been subscribed, to wit:

The capital stock of the corporation shall not be assessable except as agreed by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of all of the outstanding shares of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

That the management of this corporation shall be gvested in a Board of not less than one (1) nor more than five (5) directors, as may be fixed by the Bylaws. the directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the stockholders to be held at the general office of this corporation in the City of Challis, County of Custer, State of Idaho, on the second Monday of the first month after the close of the taxable year of each year, at a time to be determined by the Bylaws or at such other time and place as the directors may so designate. That until the first meeting of the officers, directors and stockholders of the corporation, the officers and directors of the corporation shall be the said Steve G. Long as President, Treasurer and Director; Clifford Long as Vice President and Director; and Janice Long as Secretary and Director.

ARTICLE VIII

The initial Bylaws of the corporation shall be adopted by its Board of Directors; and the power to repeal and amend Bylaws and adopt new bylaws is hereby conferred upon the directors as well as the shareholders, to be exercised by such vote of such directors or of the allotted shares, as the case may be, not less, however, than a majority thereof as may be fixed in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE IX




ARTICLE X


No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation, whether or not a majority of the shares of the capital stock of such corporation is owned by the corporation, and no act of the corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in or are directors or officers of such other corporation; any director, individually, or any firm of which said directors may be a member may be a party to or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided, that the fact that he or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been disclosed to the board of Directors or a majority

thereof; and any director of the corporation who is also a director or officer of such other corporation or who is so interested may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum of a meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize such contract or transaction and may vote thereat to authorize such contract or transaction, with a like force and effect as if he or she were not such director or officer of such other corporation or so interest.
