One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **70** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-103, 29-1101 and 29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Moscow** in the County of **Latah**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the undersigned, do hereby certify and declare that at the election for Directors of The Idaho Elwetas, Inc., of Moscow, Idaho, a fraternal organization consisting of 43 members associated together for the purpose of fraternal advantages and not for pecuniary profit, said election being held at Moscow, Idaho on the 5th day of December, 1951, a majority of the members of such organization being present and voting at said election, the following persons were unanimously elected as directors of such organization for the term of one year:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, having been duly chosen and elected the Directors of The Idaho Elwetass, Inc., of Moscow, Idaho, in accordance with the rules, regulations and discipline of said organization have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a social corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I.

That the name of this corporation is and shall be The Idaho Elwetass, Inc.

II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows: To secure for its members the advantages of fraternal association and to further the interests of the University of Idaho in every way possible, and to assist worthy young men to pursue courses of study at the University of Idaho, and to that end to acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise, real and personal property, to own and hold the same by lease or otherwise; to build, maintain and operate, or lease to others, a suitable and appropriate fraternity house in the City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho; to sell, dispose of and convey all property of the corporation, to incur such indebtedness as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this corporation and for that purpose to borrow money and execute notes, bonds and other evidences of indebtedness and to execute mortgages upon the real and personal property of the corporation to secure the repayment thereof; and to do any or all other things necessary, convenient, expedient or proper for the carrying out of the purposes of this corporation.

III.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

The principal place of business of this corporation and the location of its registered office shall be the City of Moscow, County of Latah, State of Idaho.

V.

All members heretofore duly initiated into Idaho Delta Tau Chapter of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity, and all members hereafter duly initiated into Idaho Delta Tau chapter of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity, shall automatically upon their initiation therein without any other formality or procedure be members of this corporation. In addition thereto any other members of Alpha Tau Omega, national Greek letter social fraternity, may upon majority vote of the Directors of this corporation at any special or regular meeting of such Directors, be elected to membership in this corporation. Members of this corporation shall be divided into two classes: 1 - Active Members, 2 - Alumni Members.

Active Members: Active members shall consist of the regularly enrolled students of the University of Idaho who are members of Idaho Delta Tau Chapter of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity.

Alumni Members: Alumni members shall consist of all members of Idaho Delta Tau Chapter of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity, who are not regularly enrolled students of the University of Idaho, and any other members of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity, who have been elected to membership in this corporation.

VI.

At any annual or special meeting of the members of this corporation, a quorum shall consist of a majority of the active members of this corporation.

The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors which shall consist of five members who shall be elected annually at the annual meeting of this corporation and shall serve until their successors are duly elected and qualified. The President and House Manager of Idaho Delta Tau chapter of Alpha Tau Omega, a national Greek letter social fraternity, shall be ex officio members of the Board of Directors.

VIII.

There shall be no capital stock of this corporation.
