ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WINSLOW CONSTRUCTION, INC.

WE, the undersigned, ROY H. WINSLOW, ROY H. WINSLOW, JR., and MARTHA WINSLOW, do by these presents, pursuant to and in conformity with the Civil Code of the State of Montana, and acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, associate ourselves together, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:-

1. The corporate name of said corporation shall be and is hereby declared to be:-

WINSLOW CONSTRUCTION, INC.

- 2. The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are as follows, to-wit:-
- (a) To engage in the business of earth moving, road, bridge, canal, building and all other construction of every kind and nature, and all and every type of hauling in connection with such construction.
- (b) To purchase, exchange, sell or otherwise acquire and dispose of any and all types of construction equipment, or equipment used in any manner in connection with or incidental to any and all types of construction.
- (c) To improve, manage, develop, sell, assign, transfer, lease, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of or turn to account or deal with all or any part of the property of said corporation, and from time to time vary any investment or employment of capital of the corporation.
- (d) To manufacture, buy, sell, deal in, and to engage in, conduct and carry on the business of manufacturing, buying, selling and dealing in goods, wares and merchandise of every nature and description, including both real and personal property.
- (e) To borrow money and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds,

without limit as to amount, and to secure the same as may seem desirable; and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and nature.

- (f) To enter into any kind of contract or agreement, cooperative or profit sharing plan, with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient, and to pay or reward such persons for their services as the directors may see fit.
- (g) To acquire land by purchase, lease, option, gift or in any other lawful manner to be used in connection with said business, and to erect such buildings and other structures as may be necessary to properly conduct said business, and to install fixtures and equipment of every kind in such buildings or structures owned or leased by the corporation.
- (h) To acquire in any lawful manner and to dispose of in any lawful manner any and all types of motor vehicles used in connection with said business, including passenger cars, house trailers or other trailers, portable shops, and all and every kind of tools and equipment for use in said business.
- (i) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to hold as an investment or otherwise, and to use, sign, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise deal with or dispose of stocks, bonds and other obligations and securities of itself and of other corporations; to merege or consolidate with any other corporation in such manner as may be permitted by law, and while the owner of any such stocks, bonds or other obligations or interests to exercise any and all voting powers and rights thereon permitted by law, and generally to deal with such stocks, bonds, securities and obligations in all respects as a natural person might do.
- (j) To do all and every thing necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein set forth, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the

furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals, or under the direction of any other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act and thing incidental to or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business or powers or any part or parts thereof, providing the same not be inconsistent with or contrary to the laws under which this corporation is organized.

- (k) The business or purpose of the corporation is from time to time to do any one or more of the acts or things hereinbefore enumerated, and it shall have power to conduct and carry on its said business, or any part thereof, and to have one or more offices, and to exercise any and all of its corporate powers and rights in the State of Montana, and in the various other States, territories and dependencies of the United States, in the District of Columbia, and in any and all foreign countries.
- 3. The foregoing clauses shall be construed as both objects and powers, and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be interpreted as limiting or restricting in any manner the general powers of this corporation.
- 4. The principal place of business and principal office of the corporation shall be in the Town of Whitehall, County of Jefferson, State of Montana.
- 5. That the said corporation shall commence its corporate existence upon the filing of these articles in the offices of the County Clerk and Recorder of said Jefferson County, and the Secretary of State of the State of Montana, and shall continue in existence for the term of forty (40) years thereafter.
- 6. The number of directors who shall manage and control the business of the corporation shall be three (3), and the

names and residences of the first directors who shall manage the business affairs of the said corporation for the first three months, and until their successors are elected and qualified, are:-

- 7. The capital stock of the corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) divided into One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) each.
- 8. That the amount of capital stock actually subscribed for is as follows:

9. That said capital stock shall be and is nonassessable.
