ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SANDPOINT CHRISTIAN COALITION, INC.

A Non-Profit Corporation

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the non-profit laws of the State of Idaho state the following:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be "SANDPOINT CHRISTIAN COALITION, INC.," a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

This non-profit corporation is organized exclusively to serve public charitable and public educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code, including the following:

(a) To provide a broad-based coalition of local organizations and people to examine and eliminate local insufficiencies in areas including physical needs, mental health, and human relations.

(b) To provide a non-denominational work setting enable Christians of varying doctrines to work together to do Christ's work in the world.

(c) To act as a communication vehicle to publicize inter-church and community activities.

(d) To increase the community awareness of local needs and provide concrete opportunities for those with resources and abilities to express their concern.

(e) To act as an information center for services available to the needy and to coordinate SCC efforts with existing programs.

(f) To provide a large core fund-raising/collection organization to support projects undertaken by the group.

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(g) To make distributions to organizations within the meaning of, and that qualify as, exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provisions in these articles, the following limitations shall be fully applicable and controlling:

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The name of the registered agent of the corporation is Linda Yerby. The registered address (including street and number), which is also the address of the registered agent, is 414 Superior, Sandpoint, Idaho 83864.

#### ARTICLE V - DIRECTORS

There shall be five (5) directors serving as the initial Board of Directors. Their names and addresses are as follows:

#### ARTICLE VI - DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, the net assets are to be distributed to one or more organizations selected by the then-existing Board of Directors which is organized exclusively for public charitable and/or public educational purposes and which qualify as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code then applicable.

#### ARTICLE VII - LIMITATIONS AS TO LIABILITY OF DIRECTORS

No person serving as a director of this corporation shall be personally liable to the corporation or to its members for monetary damages for conduct as a director; provided, however, that the above provision shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director for acts or omissions that involve intentional misconduct by a director or a knowing violation of law by a director, or for any transaction from which the director will personally receive a benefit in money, property, or services to which the director is not legally entitled.


