

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ART'S COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I: The name of this corporation is "Art's Company".

ARTICLE II: The purposes for which the said corporation is formed are:

(a) To engage in, conduct, promote, advertise and carry on any commercial enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to said corporation in conformity with the Laws of the State of Idaho and the purposes of this corporation shall not in any manner be limited to the following specific endeavors.

(b) To engage in, conduct, promote, advertise and carry on a lumber and logging business in any and all of its branches; to buy or otherwise acquire and sell or otherwise dispose of and in any manner deal in and with trees, logs and lumber of any kind and to purchase or otherwise acquire, bill, lease, operate, let, mortgage, sell or otherwise dispose of or deal in and with lumber mills, saw mills and other works, machinery, plants and equipment and to purchase or otherwise acquire, take on, lease or under agreement, let, mortgage sell or otherwise dispose of timber lands and wood lands.

(c) To appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation.

(d) To enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs or for the purpose of

the corporation.

(e) To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or clubs or individuals and to do every act or acts, thing or things incidental or appertinent to or growing out of or connected with the foregoing objects and purposes or any part or parts thereof provided the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

ARTICLE III: The purposes specified herein shall be construed both as purposes and powers and shall in no wise limit or restrict by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause in this or any other Article but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers and the enumeration of specific purposes and power shall not be construed to limit, restrict in any manner the meaning of the general terms or of the general powers of the corporation; nor shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another, although it is of like nature not expressed.

ARTICLE IV: The commencement of the life of this corporation shall be the date of the issuance to it of a Certificate of Incorporation by the Secretary of the State of Idaho and the duration and life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V: The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is Priest River, County of Bonner, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI: The total number of shares which this corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 480 shares. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares shall be \$24,000.00 and each share upon incorporation shall have a par value of \$50.00.

ARTICLE VII: The stock of the corporation is divided into common shares of stock only. No other stock or type of share shall be issued and shall be conveyed to the owners thereof.


ARTICLE VIII: The names and post office addresses of the incorporators and the minimum number of shares subscribed by each are as follows:




