
**NPC, INC.**

The undersigned corporation, for the purpose of dissolving the corporation, pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, hereby executes the following Articles of Dissolution.

1. The name of the corporation is NPC, INC.
2. The Dissolution was approved, as required by Chapter 1 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code and the Articles of Incorporation, at a Special Meeting of the shareholders, conducted after proper notice, on November 5, 2010.
3. A total of 244,085 shares, of the 264,672 outstanding shares of common stock, were present at the meeting, in person or by proxy, which shares constituted a quorum pursuant to the Bylaws.
4. All of the 244,085 shares, present at the meeting, voted "yes", to dissolve the corporation, after the Board of Directors, by Resolution, recommended that the corporation be dissolved.
5. The effective date of these articles of incorporation shall be date upon which they are approved and filed by the office of the Idaho Secretary of State.
