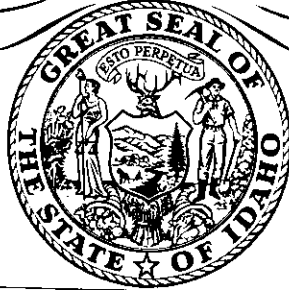

### CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION OF FOREIGN CORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
INLAND EMPIRE GOODWILL INDUSTRIES.

ARTICLE I. - NAME.

This corporation shall be known as the "INLAND EMPIRE GOODWILL INDUSTRIES." It is an auxiliary to the Department of Goodwill Industries of the Board of Home Missions and Church Extension of The Methodist Church, and the term, "Department of Goodwill Industries, " wherever used in these Articles shall mean the said Department to which this corporation is auxiliary.

ARTICLE II. - PLACE OF BUSINESS.

The principal place of business of said corporation shall be the City of Spokane, County of Spokane, State of Washington.

ARTICLE III. - TIME OF EXISTENCE.

The time of existence of this corporation shall be a body politic and corporate, with perpetual succession.

ARTICLE IV.- OBJECTS AND PURPOSES.

Section 1. The objects and purposes for which this corporation and association is formed shall be to provide for the religious, educational and industrial welfare of the poor and neglected, without profit or gain. By the inspiration of religion, by industrial education, by the encouragement of thrift and healthful conditions of living and labor, this organization shall seek to prevent pauperism; and by means of Christian cooperation it shall seek to relieve the temporary distress of the unfortunate. The purposes and objects of this corporation are solely non-profit, religious, educational and benevolent. The Association seeks to carry on its activities for the purposes and by the means and agencies herein set forth.

Section 2. The corporation shall have the right to acquire, by purchase, gift, devise, bequest, annuity, or otherwise, real and personal property, of every kind and nature, and to hold, lease, mortgage, pledge, or dispose of, the same, and to make all such contracts and agreements in behalf of the Inland Empire Goodwill Industries as may be deemed useful and convenient for the successful prosecution of its purposes.

ARTICLE V.- MEMBERSHIP.

The membership of the Inland Empire Goodwill Industries shall consist of the ministers, ex-officio, of every cooperating church or religious society in the City of Spokane, and the Inland Empire, together with a man and woman who shall be selected by each society or church so cooperating. The Superintendent and two Trustees of any benevolent society cooperating with us shall be eligible to membership. A church or religious or benevolent society which contributes at least One (\$1.00) Dollar per year for each delegate elected to this organization shall be considered a cooperating church or religious society. Also, any person firm or corporation may become a member of this organization, by the payment of One (\$1.00) Dollar each year.

ARTICLE VI.--OFFICERS.

The officers of the Inland Empire Goodwill Industries shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Superintendent, and Minister.

ARTICLE VII. - BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

The Board of Trustees of said corporation shall consist of the officers and not more than nine (9) other Trustees, who shall be elected in accordance with the By-Laws of this corporation. The number of Trustees may be increased to any number not exceeding thirty (30) in number at the annual meeting of the stockholders of said corporation, and the Board of Trustees shall have the power to fill any vacancies of Trustees should they occur during the interim between annual meetings of the stockholders. The term of office of the Trustees shall be so arranged that one-third of the elective Trustees shall be chosen each year. The Superintendent of the Spokane District of the Pacific Northwest Conference of the Methodist Church shall ex-officio be a member of the Board of Trustees.
