# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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## EL KORAH TEMPLE A.A.O.N.M.S.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, together with all other members of said El Korah Temple A.A.O.N.M.S., have this loth day of June, 1914, voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho and we certify as follows, to-wit:

I.

That the name of this corporation is:
"El Korah Temple A.A.O.N.M.S."

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That the objects for which, or for any of which, this corporation is formed shall be:

lst. To promote justice, truth and mercy everywhere and true fraternity among its members:

2nd. To acquire by gift, grant, purchase, devise, lease or otherwise both real and personal property and to own, hold, use, enjoy and dispose of the same in such manner as it may determine:

3rd. To sell, release, mortgage, exchange, lease and encumber any or all of its property at such times and in such manner as it shall determine; and to borrow money and issue evidences of indebtedness for the same in such form as it may deem advisable; and to secure the payment of such indebtedness when and as it shall determine:

4th. To erect or cause to be erected a Temple or other building or buildings for the use and accommodation

of said corporation and of its members and for such other purposes as it shall determine

5th. To make such by-laws, rules or regulations as it shall deem proper, determining the manner of admission to membership in said corporation, of what shall be necessary to maintain good standing therein and the causes for and manner of expulsion therefrom; and generally such other by-laws, rules and regulations as may be lawful.

6th. To do any and all other things or acts permitted by the laws of the State of Idaho for the purpose of carrying into effect any of the objects for which the corporation is formed.

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The principal place of business of said corporation shall be Boise City, County of Ada in the State of Idaho.

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The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

#### V.

This corporation has no capital stock.

## VI.

There shall be three directors of this corporation VII.

That the corporate power of this corporation shall be exercised in such manner as may be provided by its by-laws.

### VIII.

That at a duly called meeting of the members of said El Korah Temple A.A.O.N.M.S. held at the regular place of meeting of said Temple, to-wit: at the Masonic Hall in Boise, Idaho in June 10th 1914, an election of directors was held with the following results.to-wit:

Frank G. Emsign was duly elected Chairman of said meeting and Charles O. Nelson was duly elected secretary thereof; and the following are the names and residence of the directors who were elected for the first year (term of office for the first year to expire on the second wednesday in the month of December 1914) to-wit:

Frank G. Ensign, Boise, Idaho; Byron A. Hyatt, Boise, Idaho; Frank T. Wyman, Boise, Idaho;

of Ada County, State of Idaho and they and the Chairman and Secretary of said meeting were directed by a resolution adopted at such meeting to make and certify to these articles of incorporation; that notice of the time and place of holding said election was given by the publication of such notice for more than two weeks, immediately preceding such election in the Idaho Daily Statesman, a newspaper, published in Boise, Ada County, Idaho and also by posting a like notice for the same length of time immediately preceding such election in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held.
