## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of the

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, residents of the County of Shoshone, State of Idaho, a majority of whom are free-holders within said state, have this day associated curselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

## AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

- I. That the name of the said corporation is WYOMNING MINING AND MILLING COMPANY, and the said corporation desiring to avail itself of the provisions of an act of the legislature of the the state of Idaho, approved the sixth day of February, A. D. 1899, entitled: "An Act Limiting the Personal Liability of Stockholders of Corporations; Amending Section 2609 Revised Statutes of Idaho", shall cause to be written or printed after its corporate name, on its stock certificate, letter and bill heads, and all its official document the word "limited"; also, after the corporate signature to all official or public documents the word "limited".
- II.
