## BLACKFOOT CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the fourteenth day of May A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-two and is duly recorded on Film No. 74 of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 29-103 and Sections 29-1001 to 29-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code, Annotated.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for

perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

Blackfoot in the County of Bingham

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations, as provided in Chapter 10, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OΨ

BLACKFOOT CHAMBER OF CONMERCE, INC.

We, the undersigned, being citizens of the United States, of full age, and residents of the State of Idaho, in order to form a nonprofit cooperative association for the purposes hereinafter stated, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, have associated, and do hereby associate ourselves, and do hereby certify as follows:

The name of said association shall be: BLACKFOOT CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

II

Section 1. The purposes of the association shall be to foster and advance the civic, commercial, industrial and agricultural interests of the City of Blackfoot, Idaho, and the surrounding territory; to promote the general welfare and prosperity of the city and its surrounding territory, and to stimulate the public sentiment and activity toward accomplishment of these purposes.

Section 2. To accomplish said purposes the association shall have power to acquire, own, held, operate, mortgage, sell and dispose of such real or personal property as may from time to time be deemed necessary or desirable by the members.

Section 3. This association shall not carry on or engage in business for profit, and is not organized and shall not be conducted for the purpose, directly or indirectly, of fixing the price, or regulating the production of any article of commerce or produce of the soil, or of consumption by the people.

III

This association shall have perpetual existence.

VΣ

The location and post office address of the registered office of this association shall be the City of Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho.

V

This cooperative association shall have no capital stock, and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof. Membership shall be open to corporations, associations and partnerships, as well as to natural persons. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can or shall acquire a greater interest than any other member. Membership certificates shall be issued to each member, and shall not be assignable so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as the by-laws shall prescribe.

The government of this association shall be vested in a board of not less than eight nor more than fifteen directors, who shall be nominated and elected from the membership in such number, for such terms and in such manner as may be prescribed in the by-laws. The board of directors, in accordance with the by-laws of this association, shall elect a President, Vice-president and Secretary of the association, whose general powers and duties shall likewise be specified in the by-laws. Each of said officers, except the Secretary, shall be a member of the board of directors.

## VIII

The by-laws, in addition to other provisions, shall provide for:

- 1. The number and qualifications of members and the terms and conditions of admission.
- 2. The time, mode, conditions and effect of expulsion or withdrawal from, and of restoration to, membership.
- 3. Fees for admission, assessments or dues to carry on the affairs of the association, the time of payment and manner of collecting amounts due, and for forfeiture of the interest of a member of the association for nonpayment thereof.
- 4. Contracting, securing, paying and limiting the indebtedness of the association.

No member shall be personally liable for the debts of this association.
