DESIGNATION OF AUTHORIZED AGENT IN STATE OF IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine, and duly qualified in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Idaho to transact business as a foreign corporation in said State of Idaho, and having heretofore designated Nez Perce County in the State of Idaho as the county in which the principal place of business of said corporation in said State of Idaho is and shall be conducted,

DOES HEREBY DESIGNATE J. E. Law, residing at Lewiston, in said Nez Perce County, as Authorized Agent of said Pacific Power & Light Company in said State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of, or under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served, as provided by the Constitution and laws of said State of Idaho,

HEREBY REVOKING the appointment and designation heretofore made of W. M. Wood as such Authorized Agent for said corporation in said State of Idaho.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said Pacific Power & Light Company has caused this certificate and designation to be executed, acknowledged and delivered in its name and on its behalf in duplicate by its President, and to be attested by its Secretary, and has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed, at Portland in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, on this 21st day of November, 1917, in pursuance of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Directors of said corporation at a meeting thereof duly held on said November 21st, 1917.
