ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SCOOTER'S YOUTH HUNTING CAMP, INC. 2008 DEC 26 PM 9: 53

The undersigned citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho, Idaho Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, do hereby certify and submit to the Idaho Secretary of State:

First: The name of the Corporation shall be "Scooter's Youth Hunting Camp, Inc."

Second: The place in this state where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is at 5702 Highway 52, Emmett, Gem County, Idaho and the name and address of the registered agent for said corporation is Scott McGann, 5702 Highway 52, Emmett, Idaho 83617.

Third: Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The corporation can solicit and receive donations for said purposes.

Fourth: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial incorporators of the corporation are as follows:

Fifth: The names and addresses of the persons who are the initial directors of the corporation, of which there must be at least three (3), are as follows:

Sixth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propoganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the


corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Seventh: The mailing address for said corporation is Scooter's Youth Hunting Camp, Inc. 5702 Highway 52, Emmett, Idaho 83617.

Eighth: The corporation does not have voting members.

Ninth: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
