

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
"WEETER LUMBER COMPANY, LIMITED."

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:-

First.

That the name of said corporation is, "WEETER LUMBER COMPANY, LIMITED."

Second.

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is, to manufacture, buy, and sell, both at retail and wholesale, lumber, milldressed hardware, and all other kinds of building and fence material; also, fuel, tiling, and paving, sewer and irrigation supplies; also, to receive, hold, and sell such other property, both real and personal, as may be reasonably necessary to carry on said business, it being intended to transact said business in the State of Idaho.

Third.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the City of Pocatello, County of Bannock and State of Idaho.

Fourth.

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth.

That the number of its directors shall be five and that the names and residences of those appointed for the first year are:-

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) divided into thirty thousand shares of the par value of one dollar (\$1.00) each.

That the amount of said capital stock which has been actually subscribed is twenty one thousand three hundred and one dollars (\$21,301.00) and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to-wit:-

The liability of the stock holders in this corporation shall be "limited" and after said stock holders shall have paid the par value of the stock so subscribed for by them, they shall not be personally liable for any debts of said corporation.
