THESE PRESENTS WITNESS: That I, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter specified and in conformity to the laws of the State of Idaho and to the Professional Service Corporation Act, do hereby make and subscribe the following written Articles of Incorporation, in duplicate:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Robert Berghan, M. D. P. A.

ARTICLE II

The time of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this corporation is the practice of the profession of medicine and the investing of the corporate funds in real estate, personal property, mortgages, stocks, bonds, insurance, or any other type of investment and to mortgage and encumber the same and to deal generally therein.

ARTICLE IV

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 10,000 shares of common stock with no par value. None of said capital stock will be issued to anyone other than an individual

who is duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice as a medical doctor in the State of Idaho. No capital stock of this corporation shall be transferred to any person or entity not legally authorized to practice as a medical doctor in the State of Idaho, whether such transfer be voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law and in the event such an unauthorized transfer of the capital stock of the corporation would otherwise occur, the corporation shall be irrevocably bound to redeem such stock, which said stock shall then become treasury stock of the corporation and may be sold by the corporation only to an individual legally authorized to practice as a medical doctor in the State of Idaho. Each shareholder of the corporation shall enter into a written agreement with the corporation providing for the redemption of all of the shareholder's stock which might otherwise be transferred to any person ineligible to be a whether shareholder such transfer would bе voluntary, involuntary, or by operation of law.

ARTICLE V

The aggregate value of the shares of common stock will not be in excess of \$100,000.00.
