

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the
APPLE VALLEY FRUIT COMPANY.

We, the undersigned, do by these presents associate ourselves together, under and by virtue of Chapter One, Title IX of the Code of Iowa, and the laws amendatory thereto, and do adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:-

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be the Apple Valley Fruit Company, and its principal place of business shall be at Sioux City, in the County of Woodbury and State of Iowa, but it may have business offices wherever it may establish the same, and in the State of Idaho, and either within or without the said state of Iowa.

ARTICLE II.

The nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be to buy and sell real estate, to own, operate and develop orchards in the state of Idaho and other places, and to care for, handle and operate orchards, lands and real estate and properties for corporations, persons, individuals and others in the state of Idaho and elsewhere, and to engage in a general land business and to buy, sell, lease and exchange all kindsof property, both real and personal, notes, mortgages bonds and securities, shares of stock of any corporation, including the shares of this company, and to do and perform every act and thing necessary to carry out said purposes in other states and jurisdictions which like corporations organized therein may lawfully do therein.

ARTICLE III.

The amount of the authorized capital stock of this corporation shall be the sum of Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) divided into two hundred shares of the par value of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) each, and One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of which capital stock shall be fully paid in in cash before the corporation transacts business, except as incident to its organization. Said stock to be issued at such times as the board of directors may authorize.

ARTICLE IV.

This corporation shall commence business upon the 10th day of September, 1913, and continue for a term of twenty years thereafter, with a right of renewal as provided by law.

ARTICLE V.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be five and each director shall hold at least one share of stock, and the following shall serve as directors until their successors are chosen and qualified:- N. Balkema, K. B. Cleminson, U. G. Selden, F. O. Hicks and E. G. Johnson.

The annual meeting of the stockholders shall be held on the second Monday of January in each year at the office of the corporation at Sioux City, Iowa, and the first annual meeting of the stockholders shall be on the second Monday of January, 1915. At all elections and meetings of stockholders each stockholder shall be entitled to one vote for each share of stock held by said stockholder, to be cast in person or by written proxy. The directors shall be elected annually at the annual meeting, commencing with the said meeting to be held on the second Monday of January, in the year 1915, and they shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and qualified. Vacancies occurring in the board of directors may be filled by the board of directors.

ARTICLE VI.

The officers shall consist of a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer. No person shall be elected president who is not also a director. Said officers shall be elected by the board of directors at a meeting to be held annually following the annual meeting of the stockholders and they shall hold office for one year and until their successors are elected and qualified. Any vacancy occurring may be filled by the board of directors.

Until their successors are elected and qualified the following shall be the officers of this corporation:-President, N. Balkema; vice-president, K. B. Cleminson; Secretary, U.G. Selden; Treasurer, U. G. Selden.
