of Keerins & Kelly Ford Equipment Co.

That all of the shareholders of Keerins & Kelly Ford Equipment Co. who are also all of the shareholders of said corporation entitled to vote on the affairs of the corporation, did, on the 22nd day of July, 1960, at Nampa, Idaho, individually and unanimously give their written consent to the amendment of the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation so as to amend Articles I and VI of the Articles of Incorporation.
