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- 1 (e) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of,
2 convey, mortgage and/or lease real and personal
3 property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign,
4 transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights
5 privileges, franchises, real or personal
6 property of the corporation, other than its
7 franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire,
8 purchase, guarantee, hold, mortgage, own, vote,
9 sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and
10 deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures
11 and other evidences of indebtedness of other
12 corporations, domestic or foreign.
- 13 (f) To appoint such officers, employees and agents
14 as the business of the corporation may require
15 and to allow them compensation.
- 16 (g) To enter into contracts or obligations of any
17 kind or type essential, necessary or proper to
18 the transactions of its ordinary affairs or
19 for the purpose of the corporation.
- 20 (h) To conduct business in the State of Idaho or
21 other states and territories of the United
22 States and in foreign countries and to have one
23 or more offices and places of business in or out
24 of the State of Idaho and to acquire, receive,
25 hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of
26 and or convey real and personal property situate
27 within or without the State of Idaho.
- 28 (i) To apply for, acquire, hold, use, own, operate,
29 dispose of by sale or otherwise, mortgage,
30 hypothecate, lease and/or to sell and grant
31 licenses in respect of patents, trade marks,
32 trade names, inventions, improvements, processes,
copyrights and licenses therefor.
- (j) To execute, issue, negotiate promissory notes,
bills of exchange, bonds, debentures, negotiable
instruments, securities and other obligations of
this corporation and to secure any of the same
by pledge, mortgage, deeds of trust or other
hypothecation of any or all of the property of the
corporation.
- (k) In connection with the carrying on of the business
of the corporation, to lend and advance money,
credit, property of the corporation and to render
aid by guarantee or in any other manner gratuitously
or on such terms as may seem expedient on open
account, secured or unsecured, to any person, firm,
association or corporation.
- (l) To purchase, subscribe for or otherwise acquire,
own, manage, hold, use, operate, lease, mortgage,
hypothecate, pledge, exchange, assign, transfer,
sell or otherwise dispose of immovable and movable
property of every kind and description, including
shares of stock, bonds, indentures, notes, evidences
of indebtedness and other securities, contracts or
obligations of this or any other corporation,
association or firm, and to pay therefor in

1 whole or in part in cash or by exchanging
2 therefor stocks, bonds, or other evidence of in-
3 debtedness or securities of this or any other
4 corporation and to receive, collect and dispose
5 of the interest, dividends, and income arising
6 from such property and to possess and exercise
7 in respect thereof all the rights, powers and
8 privileges of ownership including all voting
9 powers of any stocks or other securities so owned,
10 controlled, managed or operated.

11 (m) Generally to do any and all things necessary or
12 proper in carrying on the business of the corpora-
13 tion and to enter into, make, perform and carry
14 out contracts, leases and franchises of every
15 kind and nature relating to or connected with
16 the business or any phase thereof in which the
17 corporation may be or is from time to time engaged
18 upon and to do everything necessary, proper or
19 useful for the accomplishment of the objectives
20 and principles herein enumerated, or necessary,
21 proper or convenient to the benefit of the
22 corporation for the furtherance of its business
23 propositions.

24 (n) The foregoing clauses are to be considered as ob-
25 jectives, purposes and powers and the enumeration
26 of specific powers shall not limit or restrict in
27 any manner the powers of the corporation, it being
28 the intention that the objectives and powers speci-
29 fied in this or any other article herein shall in
30 nowise be limited or restricted by reference to or
31 by inference from the terms of any other article
32 or clause thereof, but the same may be and is
extended thereby.

33 ARTICLE III.

34 The principal place of transaction of the business of this
35 corporation and its post office address and registered office shall
36 be at ~~Hampe, Canyon County~~, Idaho, but the corporation may establish
37 and maintain such subordinate and branch offices as may be hereafter
38 decided or determined upon by the corporation by or through its
39 Board of Directors, whether in the State of Idaho or such other
40 states or places as may from time to time be determined upon.
