CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

THE HARVESTERS, INC.,

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Eighteenth** day of **November** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty** and is duly recorded on Film No. **113** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Payette**, in the County of **Payette**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE HARVESTERS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which directors have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, a religious corporation to be known as "THE HARVESTERS, INC.".

ARTICLE I.

That we, the undersigned, certify that the objects for which this corporation is formed are:

1. It shall be the purpose of this organization to spread the Gospel of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, to win others to Him and to teach the Word of God to any and all who will hear, that thereby they may be better established and more able to bring glory to His wonderful Name;

2. It shall be the privilege of this organization to spread the Gospel by whatever means there may be available for that purpose. Some of the primary means to be used by this organization in spreading the Gospel are: radio broadcasting, printed page, personal evangelism, Sunday School work, public preaching services and Bible Study classes;

3. This organization is incorporated as a non-profit organization.

ARTICLE II.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III.

The term of this incorporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

It shall be necessary for any one either incorporating with this organization or being accepted into it by action of the board of directors to subscribe to the following statement of faith:

1 1. The Holy Scriptures: We believe that the Old and New Testaments are
2 verbally inspired of God and are the Word of God and are the final authority for
3 faith and life and are inerrant in the original writings.

4 2. The Godhead: We believe in one triune God, existing in three persons,
5 Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

6 3. The Depravity of Man: We believe that although man was created in the
7 image of God, still he sinned and fell, and that in that first man's fall all the
8 human race became fallen, alienated from God, totally depraved and utterly unable
9 to alter its lost condition.

10 4. Salvation: We believe that salvation is a free gift of God, that it was
11 purchased at terrible cost by our blessed Lord on Calvary and that it is now
12 absolutely free to any and all who will, in simple faith, cast themselves upon
13 Him, trusting Him alone for their complete salvation.

14 5. Eternal Security: We believe that all those who are born again are
15 in the covenant care and keeping of God and that they are as eternally saved and
16 safe the moment that they place their trust in Him as they will be even after
17 they are in eternity.

18 6. Dispensationalism: We believe in the dispensational view in Bible
19 interpretation.

20 7. The Return of our Lord: We believe in the personal return of our Lord
21 for His own, and that such appearing may take place at any moment. We accept the
22 pre-millenial view on prophecy. We accept what is commonly termed the pre-tribu-
23 lation rapture view, as touching our Lord's return for His saints. We believe
24 that after the church has been caught up to meet her Lord in the air that the
25 world will suffer a terrible time of tribulation at the close of which period our
26 Lord shall return to this earth with his Saints, and that at that time He shall
27 set up His millenial kingdom and rule and reign with Jerusalem as His capital city.
28 We believe that this kingdom shall be both literal and wonderful and that it shall
29 last for one thousand years.

ARTICLE V.

31 1. This organization shall be composed of a Board of Directors of at least
32 three (3) and not to exceed fifteen (15) members.

1 2. New members may be added to this Board at any monthly business meeting
2 by a three-fourths (3/4) majority vote of the Board, providing that such addition
3 does not make the total number of members to exceed the number, fifteen.

4 3. Members may be dismissed from the Board of Directors of this organiza-
5 tion at any monthly business meeting, by offering their resignation, in writing,
6 which will in turn be voted upon by the remaining members of the Board. This vote
7 must carry a majority. Members also may be dismissed from this organization by a
8 one hundred (100) per cent majority vote of the remaining members providing that
9 such intention to dismiss a member has been plainly declared to the Board of Di-
10 rectors and placed in the minutes at the previous regular monthly business meeting.

11 4. From the members of this Board of Directors there shall be elected by
12 majority vote, a president, a secretary and a treasurer.

18 5. Each one of the incorporators of this organization are of legal age,
19 each of them being more than twenty-one years of age. The names and addresses

ARTICLE VI.

22 These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a three-fourths (3/4)
23 majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors of this organization, such
24 amendment having first been submitted, in writing, at the previous regular monthly
25 business meeting.

ARTICLE VII.

28 We further certify that at a meeting of the members of THE HARVESTERS, INC.
29 duly convened for the purpose hereinafter set forth, held at 633 North Sixth
30 Street, at Payette, Idaho, on the 7th day of November, 1960, at 8:30 o'clock P.M.,
31 a majority of said members being then and there present voted at said election;
32 that Charles Webb was requested to preside and Barbara Webb was requested to act

1 as secretary, with which request they, respectively, complied; that the meeting
2 then proceeded to the election of three (3) Directors to take charge and manage-
3 ment of the properties, temporalities and affairs of said religious corporation
4 and to form an incorporation under the laws of the State of Idaho in furtherance
5 of the objects for which the religious corporation was founded.

6 That the following Directors were duly elected, namely:--

7 Charles Webb, President

8 Barbara Webb, Secretary

9 Bernice Jacks, Treasurer.

10 That the notice of the time and place of the meeting was duly published for
11 two (2) successive weeks prior to the meeting in the Independent-Enterprise, a
12 weekly newspaper printed and published in the County of Payette, State of Idaho,
13 and said notice was also posted conspicuously for two (2) weeks at the place where
14 the meeting was held.




