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ARTICLE FOUR REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Ron Goodwin and the initial registered office shall be located at 650 Nina Drive, Rexburg, Idaho 83440.

ARTICLE FIVE STOCK

The total number of par value shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1000 shares each having a par value of \$1.00. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par value shares is \$1,000. There are no authorized shares without par value.

The stock of the corporation is divided into 1,000 shares of a single class, each share having equal rights and each share having one vote. All stock when fully paid for shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE SIX BOARD OF DIRECTORS & BY LAWS
