ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is Eleganza Homeowners Association, Inc. (hereinafter called "Corporation").

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL AND REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE AND POWERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The purposes for which the Association is formed are:

1. The Corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Its specific and primary purpose shall be to manage and associate Eleganza Subdivision. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

2. The general purpose and power of the Corporation is to have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement both of purposes and of powers, and purposes and powers in each clause shall in no wise be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be broadly construed as independent purposes and powers. Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have two classes of members. "Class A" shall be composed of all the owners of lots in Eleganza Subdivision except the incorporator. "Class B" shall be composed of the incorporator. "Class B" shall cease to exist and all members thereof shall become "Class A" members on January 1, 2010, or on the date incorporator ceases to own any of the lots in Eleganza Subdivision, whichever occurs sooner. Members shall elect the Board of Directors and be eligible to serve as a director.

The corporation will have voting members.

ARTICLEVI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Corporation shall initially be managed by a board of three (3) directors. The number of directors may be changed by amendment of the Corporation.
