




That they desire for themselves, their associates, successors and assigns, to be incorporated under the name and style of

BROWN TRANSPORT RENTALS, INC.

for the term of thirty-five years.

2.

The principal office of said business shall be located in Burke County, Georgia, with the right and privilege of establishing branch offices and places of business elsewhere, both within and without the State of Georgia.

3.

The object of said corporation is pecuniary gain to itself and its stockholders.

4.

The general nature of the business of said corporation shall be that of owning, operating, leasing and carrying on the business of motor vehicle transportation, including the transportation for hire of property and/or persons, both as common and contract carriers, both within and without the State of Georgia and in interstate, foreign and intrastate commerce, including the buying, owning, operating, leasing and selling of certificates of public convenience and neces-

sity, permits and other operating authority issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission and the various State regulatory bodies, and also the owning, leasing, selling and trading in motor vehicles and motor trucks and equipment and also the operation and maintenance of terminals, warehouses and offices and all necessary and proper facilities in connection with the business of motor vehicle transportation for hire, and to do any and all things or acts necessary, usual, customary or incidental to the business of motor vehicle transportation for hire, or which may hereafter in a development of said business become necessary or usual in the conduct of a business of such character.

5.

The capital stock of said corporation shall be \$20,000.00, divided into two thousand (2,000) shares of the par value of \$10.00 each, all of which shall be common stock.

6.

The amount of capital stock with which the corporation shall begin business is \$20,000.00.

7.

Said corporation shall be authorized to issue stock for any consideration, either money, property or services, which is at least equivalent to the full par value of the stock so to be issued. The valuation of any property or services for such purpose will be fixed by the Directors of the corporation and such method of valuation will be conclusive.
