We, the undersigned, E. E. Duncan and Mrs. Gus Olson, hereby certify that we are President and Secretary, respectively, of the Board of Trustees of Eureka Water Company, a corporation, organized under the laws of Idaho Territory, with its principal place of business at Eureka School House, in Ada County, Idaho; that the Articles of Incorporation of said company were filed in the office of the Secretary of Idaho Territory on April 26, 1881, and were filed in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of the 2nd Judicial District of Idaho Territory on said 26th day of April, 1881; that under Article 5 of the Articles of Incorporation of said company it was to continue to exist for a period of fifty years from the 26th day of April, 1881; that its term of existence as a corporation expired on April 26, 1931.

That as provided in Article 4 of its Articles of Incorporation the capital stock consisted of \$550.00 and was divided into 11 shares of \$50.00 each; that on February 11, 1922, said Articles of Incorporation were amended by increasing the capital stock from 11 shares of the par value of \$50.00 per share to 2,000 shares of the par value of \$5.00 per share; that said Amendment was filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, on March 11, 1922, and was also filed in the office of the County Recorder of Ada County, Idaho, on March 1, 1922.

That the total number of shares of stock outstanding in said corporation is ________; that the holders of said outstanding stock filed with the Secretary of said corporation written consent to the term of existence of said corporation being extended perpetually and requesting the President and Secretary of the Board of Trustees of said company to take such action as shall be necessary to extend the time of the existence of

said corporation, as provided in Chapter 36, Idaho Session Laws of 1945.

That pursuant to said written consents of the stockholders and the action of the Board of Trustees of said corporation in regard thereto, it is hereby requested that the term of existence of said Eureka Water Company be made perpetual.
