ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this organization shall be the Idaho Trail Machine Association, Inc. (ITMA).

ARTICLE II

Statement

The ITMA is a nonprofit corporation organized under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The period of existence and duration of the life of this Organization shall be perpetual unless dissolved or terminated according to law.

ARTICLE IV Purposes

- (a) To encourage, organize and assist the development of opportunities, activities, and functions, for the recreational uses of motorized trail machines; to assist in the formation and growth of ITMA chapter clubs; to assist all persons, groups and organizations in active support of lawful use of all such vehicles; and to encourage safe operation of such vehicles.
- (b) The organization shall embody principles of multiple use and sustained yield and that our nation's public lands should be for the benefit of all Americans.
- (c) To defend and enhance recreational access, via motorized means, to public lands. The organization will also work toward the preservation of natural resources and natural values in concert with opportunities for humans to gain access to and interact directly with their physical environment.
- (d) To afford an enlightened and organized advocacy in all levels of government relative to the use of motorized trail machines, with the primary objective to protect the proper enjoyment and use of the recreational aspects of all public lands.
- (e) To develop, encourage, organize, assist and sponsor regular and special activities, events, and functions, including an annual convention.
- (f) To encourage all members to cooperate and to exhibit good sportsmanship among themselves and in all relationships with other members and groups; and to promote unity in the effort to protect recreational access for motorized trail machines.

ARTICLE VI Membership

Admittance of chapters to member chapter status in ITMA shall be by petition to and approval by the Board

Voting membership in ITMA shall be through member chapters. Each member of a member chapter is a member of ITMA. For the purposes of determining number of ITMA board members, dues collection, and voting on ITMA matters, the voting membership number of a member chapter shall be equal to the total number of single members of the local chapter plus two times the total number of family memberships of the local chapter. Other memberships to be determined by the Board.

ARTICLE VII Directors and Officers

Members of the Board of Directors shall be chosen by ITMA member chapters in accordance with member chapter bylaws. Each member chapter shall have two seats on the Board of Directors. The term of office for board members shall start at an annual meeting and shall extend as a minimum to the next annual meeting and as a maximum to the fourth following annual meeting. Member chapters shall select the term for their selected board members such that terms of their selected board members expire in staggered years. Any vacancy in the board shall be filled by the affected member chapter. The terms of office and provisions addressing officers shall be determined in the by-laws.

ARTICLE VIII Liability

No director, officer or member of this nonprofit corporation shall be liable for any debt, obligation or liability of this corporation, whether such debt, obligation or liability is incurred in the regular course of the business of this corporation or during public meetings or events sponsored by this Association for the purpose of fund-raising, public education or other.

ARTICLE IX Dissolution

Upon the dissolution or other termination of the ITMA, no part of the property of the Association, nor any proceeds thereof, shall be distributed to, or inure to the benefit of, any of the Directors or Officers, but all such property and proceeds shall, subject to the discharge of valid obligations of the corporation and to applicable provisions of law, be distributed to the BlueRibbon Coalition or its successor entity. In the event the BlueRibbon Coalition or a successor does not exist at the time of dissolution or other termination of the corporation, no part of the property of the corporation, nor any of the proceeds thereof, shall be distributed to, or inure to the benefit of, any of the directors of the corporation, but all such property and proceeds shall, subject to the discharge of valid obligations of the corporation and to applicable provisions of law, be distributed, as directed by the Board of Directors of ITMA to or among any one or more corporations, trusts, community chests, funds or foundations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
