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JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF LEWISTON-CLARKSTON, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and certify as follows:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be: JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF LEWISTON-CLARKSTON, INC.

Article II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) Specifically and primarily to educate boys and girls in the basic concepts of Americanism, and as one of said basic concepts, in a knowledge of and respect for what is universally known and recognized as the American private enterprise system; and in connection therewith, to provide opportunities for boys and girls to organize themselves into small enterprises, to be wholly operated by them, under the guidance of advisors furnished by business firms participating in the program, and thus to acquire a knowledge of the problems and fundamentals of business.
- (b) To receive property by gift, devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by will, and otherwise acquire and hold all property, real or personal.
- (c) To convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, encumber, transfer upon trust, or otherwise dispose of all property, real and personal.
- (d) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation, and to receive, hold, administer, and expend funds and property subject to such trust.
- (e) To borrow money, contract debts, execute notes, and secure the payment or performance of its obligations.
- (f) To make contracts; and to do all other acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of the corporation.

Article III.

The period of existence and the duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.
