ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

"ORION CLUB."

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, we, whose names are subscribed hereto, all residents of the State of Idaho, and all of whom have been duly elected directors of this corporation, in pursuance of the notice of election hereunto attached, have this day associated curselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

FIRST.

That the name of said corporation shall be "Orion Club".

BECOND.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed, are:

- (a) To promote the social, moral, and intellectual welfare of the members of this corporation, and to improve, encourage, and build up the fraternal and brotherly spirit of its members, and to provide for their general welfare.
- (b) To promote good fellowship, charity, and friendship among its members and mankind generally.
- (c) To acquire, lease, own, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, or ocnvey, such real estate as may be necessary or convenient in carrying out the purposes for which this corporation is formed, or in promoting its general welfare.
- (d) To own, furnish, manage, and operate, a club house, or club houses, for the proper housing and caring for its members.
- (e) To borrow money and to secure the payment of the same by the pledge, or mortgage, of any or all property, which the company may have, own, or central.

(f) And, for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or purposes, to do any and all other acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, which a natural person could to, or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law.

TEIRD.

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, or gain.

FOURTH.

That the principal office, and the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted, is in the City of Caldwell, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

FIFTH.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist, is fifty years, from and after the date of its incorporation.

SIXTH.

That the corporate powers of this corporation shall be vested in a board of directors, composed of seven persons, and that the names and places of residence of these persons who are chosen for directors for the first year, next succeeding, are:

SEVENTH.

That this is a membership corporation, and there is no capital stock, but all members in good standing, are, by virtue of membership, members of the corporation.
