

Articles of Association of the
Sho-sho-see Mining Company.

Know all men by these presents:
That we whose names are hereunto
subscribed, do hereby certify and declare
our desire to form, and do hereby form
a body corporate, under and by virtue
of the laws of The Territory of Idaho
for the purpose of carrying on our
business of mining and working
mines, and dealing in ore and metals.

I. The name of this corporation
shall be "The Sho-sho-see Mining Company"

II. The object for which the company
is formed is the business of general mining
and mining in the Territory of Idaho
and the working and dealing in ore
and metals in said Territory, and
more especially in view of acquiring
and working certain mines or lots known
respectively as the "Type", "Copper" and
"Dark Hill" all located in the County of
Blaine - Territory of Idaho.

III. The capital stock of this company
shall be two hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) divided into two thousand shares
of the par value of One Hundred dollars
(\$100) each, which are now unissued.

IV. The affairs of the Company shall be managed by a Board of three Trustees and such other officers as they may from time to time elect, under a code of By-Laws to be adopted by the Board upon its organization.

V. There shall be an annual meeting of the stockholders to elect a Board of Trustees for the ensuing year, and to consider the affairs of the Company. All acts of the Board of Trustees shall be subject to revision by the stockholders in meeting assembled, and any By-Laws may be repealed or amended by a vote of the stockholders representing all of the stock outstanding.

VI. General and special meetings of the stockholders and Board of Trustees shall be held upon such notice as may be prescribed by the By-Laws, at the principal office of the Company in Idaho.

VII. The principal office of the Company shall be located at Pinedale, Shoshone County, Idaho Territory, and its business shall be carried on in said County and Territory.

VIII. The term of the existence of the Corporation shall be twenty years.

The first Board of Trustees shall consist of the following persons "to wit" —
 John Hewitt of Chicago Illinois, ^{and}
 Elliot A. Holdings ^{or} Silas W. Moody
 of Deere City, who shall continue in office
 until their successors are elected, at the
 first annual meeting of the Stock holders.
 TX. At no time shall the indebtedness
 of this Company exceed the sum of
 One Thousand Dollars.
