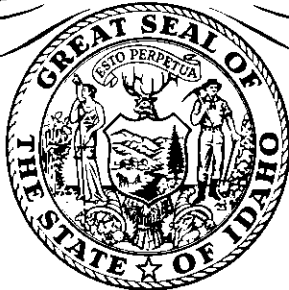

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

BUHL HERALD, INCORPORATED

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fifteenth** day of **January,** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty,** and duly recorded on Film No. **110** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Buhl,** in the County of **Twin Falls.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BUHL HERALD, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day, voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of said corporation shall be Buhl Herald, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- (1) To carry on the newspaper and publishing business and the business of printers and lithographers, stereotypers, electrotypers, photographic printers, photolithographers, engravers, die-sinkers, blank book manufactures, book binders, and stationers, and the printing of books, pamphlets, periodicals, newspapers, posters, circulars, envelopes, bills and letterheads, cards, tags, labels, commercial, financial, and law blanks and forms of every description, railroad and other tickets and any and all kinds of documents, instruments, and other printed matter.
- (2) To manufacture, lease, license, buy, and otherwise acquire, and to sell either at wholesale or at retail, exchange, repair, install, trade, and deal in printing presses of any and every description; paper cutting, numbering, and ruling machines and other machinery, devices, utensils and supplies used by printers; machines, devices, appliances, instruments for mechanical or handwriting with the production of written matter, and typewriters, type-writing devices of any and all kinds and typewriter materials, accessories, appliances and inventions; office equipment and furniture and devices of any and every kind; and supplies, adjuncts, parts or accessories, and materials suitable or convenient for use in connection with any of the articles or in any way relating hereto.
- (3) To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sub-lease, or otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, buildings, easements or property, both real and personal, including all types and kinds of equipment which are re-

quisite for or are conveniently capable of being used in connection with any of the objects of this corporation, and to enter into, make perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any persons, and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises, options and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, or corporation, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.

- (4) To purchase or acquire property, business rights, or franchises or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, notes or other evidence of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise, shares of its own corporate stock and cancel the same or any part thereof, or hold all or any of such stock for resale as treasury stock, or for the purpose of making stock dividends to its shareholders and to restrict the transferability of its outstanding shares.
- (5) To act as surety or creditor in any and all types of engagements including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts, notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership or corporation, and to act as accomodation co-maker or guanantor on obligations, either as primary or secondary obligor.
- (6) Without, in any manner, limiting any of the objects, purposes or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of said corporation shall be, from time to time, to do any one or more or all of the acts or things herein set forth.
- (7) The several subdivisions contained in this paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumerations thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict, in any manner, the general powers conferred on business corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which powers are hereby expressly claimed.

ARTICLE III.

That the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Buhl, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho; and that the post office address of the regis-

tered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Buhl, Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, divided into Five Thousand (5000) shares of a par value of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars each; and that the total authorized number of shares shall be Five Thousand (5000) and the aggregate par value shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars. That all of said stock shall be known as common stock and shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation which has been actually subscribed is One Hundred Twenty (\$120.00) Dollars; and that the names and post office addresses of the incorporators, and the number of shares subscribed by each are as follows:
