Article 2. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is as follows. To promote the educational, inspirational and general welfare of the Loyal Order of Moose and its associate auxiliaries; to bring together in closer fraternal cooperation the various lodges of the Loyal Order of Moose, and the membership of such lodges in the states of Washington and Idaho; to aid and promote the aims and purposes of the Loyal Order of Moose in the states of Washington and Idaho; to exchange ideas and ideals which may be of benefit to the various lodges and their members; to promote interest in the work of ritualistic teams; to encourage or broaden interest in the various lodges in athletics and sports; to stimulate participation in civic activities and programs that aid in the development of our communities; to foster closer relationships between the Moose Lodges in Washington and Idaho. This corporation is incorporated in conformity with, subject to and under the jurisdiction and control of the laws for the regulation of lodges in the Loyal Order of Moose and is subject to the constitution and general laws of Moose International, Inc., all of which are to be carried out not for profit and without shares of stock.

Its business affairs shall be conducted by its members in good standing and by its respective officers in the manner and at such times as are prescribed by the Constitution and General Laws of Moose International, Inc.

The membership of said corporation shall consist of only the members in good standing of said fraternal association known as Washington-Northern Idaho Moose Association, Inc.

This State Association shall have perpetual existence.

Article 8. The dissolution for any cause whatsoever of the said fraternal association as a fraternal Association of that system of Associations known in the aggregate as the Loyal Order of Moose, shall forthwith work a dissolution of this corporation, and in such event, the affairs of the corporation shall be wound up and terminated in accordance with the laws of this State and in compliance with the Constitution and General Laws of Moose International, Inc.
