ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

AMERICAN DISTRIBUTION, INC.

1. The name of the corporation is **AMERICAN DISTRIBUTION, INC.**

2. The registered office of the corporation is located at 907 Timber Lane, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83814.

3. The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the general corporation law of the State of Idaho.

4. The total number of shares of common stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 20,000, all of which shall be no par value stock.

5. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
