was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **29th** day of **August** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-seven** and is duly recorded on Film No. **99** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Coeur d'Alene** in the County of **Kootenai** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NORTH IDAHO ASSOCIATION OF LIFE UNDERWRITERS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we the undersigned, residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, and all of lawful age, do hereby adopt the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE I

We do hereby designate the name of this proposed corporation to be the NORTH IDAHO ASSOCIATION OF LIFE UNDERWRITERS, INC.;

ARTICLE II

The location and Post Office Address of this corporation shall be Post Office Box 908, Coeur d'Alene, and its principal place of business shall be in Coeur d'Alene, County of Kootenai, State Of Idaho;

ARTICLE III

The object and purpose of this corporation is as follows: To hold, sell, lease, purchase, receive, and convey real and personal property; to enter into lawful contract, to raise money and to pay debts of this corporation, to do charitable work, to receive and pay out money for charitable purposes; to support and maintain the principle of legal reserve life insurance; to advance public knowledge of legal reserve life insurance and its uses; to promote the adoption and application of higher standards of ethical conduct in the profession of life underwriting and the business of life insurance; to increase the knowledge of agents concerning legal reserve life insurance, its uses and its sale; to provide through this Association for rendering community service and for forming enduring friendships; to create and maintain a sound public opinion, to promote cooperation and good will, and in all other ways to promote the best interest of legal reserve life insurance; and to do any other lawful act which is necessary or expedient for the above object and purpose.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is to be a Non-Profit organization and no capital stock shall be issued and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared thereof. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal.

ARTICLE V

Membership in this corporation shall be according to the constitution and by-laws hereafter adopted.

## ARTICLE VI

This corporation shall have perpetual existence from and after the date of its incorporation.

## ARTICLE VII

A total of seven (7) directors shall be elected to manage the affairs of this corporation and these shall be elected for the terms provided in the By-Laws and shall constitute a board of directors. This board of directors shall elect a president, vic-president, secretary, treasurer, one national committee man, and two directors to be officers of this corporation. Each officer of this corporation must be a director also.
