and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for
fifty years from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located

Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30,
Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PARMA JAY-C-ETTES, INC.

ORGANIZED

UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States and bonafide residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, over the age of 21 years, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming and incorporating a non-profit, benevolent, charitable, and fraternal organization under and by the virtue of the provisions of Chapter 11 of Title 29, Idaho Code annotated, 1932, as amended, and hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation of said association, and we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

NAME

That the name of this corporation is: Parma Jay-C-Ettes, Inc.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation is a non-profit organization, and is formed for benevolent, charitable, and social purposes, and especially as follows:

1. To provide the wives of the younger business and professional men of the City of Parma, a medium for training in citizenship; to promote the civic, industrial and educational activities of the community; to secure and disseminate accurate information relating thereto; to oppose legislation unfavorable thereto; and to support and promote legislation favorable thereto.
2. To cooperate with the Parma Junior Chamber of Commerce, Inc., in advancing its program of usefulness to the City, State and Nation.
3. To purchase or otherwise acquire and to hold, own and exercise all rights, of ownership in real estate and personal property and to sell, transfer or mortgage said real estate and personal property; to borrow money, to erect buildings or other structures necessary and proper for carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to enter into all contracts necessary in conducting its affairs; to render such benevolence, aid and assistance to its members as are provided by its By-Laws; and to receive donations and manage, take and hold real and personal property by gift, grant, devise, or bequest.

ARTICLE III

PLACE OF BUSINESS

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Parma, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

TERM OF EXISTANCE

That the term for which this corporation is to exist shall be fifty (50) years from and after the date of its corporation.

ARTICLE V

CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation does not have and shall not have any capital stock, neither shall it issue to its members, certificates representing capital stock and this corporation shall not be operated for a pecuniary profit.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

The number of Directors of this corporation shall be five (5) and the term of office, qualifications of Directors and manner of election shall be provided for in the By-Laws. The names and addresses of those who are to serve as incorporating Directors and until the election and qualification of the successors; are as follows:

ARTICLE VII

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pursuant of notice published in the Parma Review, a newspaper published in Parma, Canyon County, Idaho, on October 8, 1952, and October 15, 1952, a copy of which notice may be obtained from the Parma Review, a meeting of the members of the Parma Jay-C-Ettes, inc., was held on Monday, the 20th day of October, 1952, at the hour of 8:00 O'clock, P.M., at which time and place a majority of the members of this association were present and voted at the election held at said meeting and the persons above named were duly elected as the incorporation Directors for the first year of this corporation and until the election and qualification of their successors, and that Mary Dell Walz and Katherine Seely were the President and Secretary respectively of said meeting and were the officers conducting said election.

ARTICLE VIII

AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any respect at any regular or special meeting of members called for that purpose. An amendment must first be approved by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors and then adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present and voting at said meeting; provided, that a quorum, as specified by the By-Laws of said corporation be present. Notice of any proposed amendment shall after approval of two-thirds of the Board of Directors, be given to the members in the manner provided by Section 29-1103 of the Idaho Code Annotated 1932.
