CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

PK'S FM, INCORPORATED,

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Tenth** day of **August** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and duly recorded on Film No. **120** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls,** in the County of **Bonneville.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

P K ' S F M, I N C O R P O R A T E D

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho.

WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation is PK'S FM, Incorporated.

SECOND: That the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To engage in the business of broadcasting and/or radio-casting by means of radio broadcasting equipment or any other devices. To own, sell, lease, equip, maintain and operate broadcasting and receiving stations and any connections between such stations, to transmit, send and broadcast over the radio news, talks, speeches, lectures, musicals, concerts, plays, recitals, programs, reviews, readings, reports, signals, and all matter and things of any nature, kind and description whatsoever that may be transmitted, sent and broadcast by radio, and including programming and broadcasting of background music to commercial establishments, offices and other agencies upon subscription or contract arrangement, and to conduct all business in any way connected with, related to or arising from the ownership or operation of private and/or public radio broadcasting station or stations.

2. To purchase and otherwise acquire, own, sell, assign or otherwise transfer and convey, trade, deal in and with goods, wares, merchandise and property of every class, variety and description.

3. To hold, purchase or otherwise acquire, to sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of capital stock, bonds or other evidence of indebtedness created by any other corporation, and while the holder of such stock to exercise all the rights and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

4. To make, enter into and execute contracts of every kind and character with individuals, firms, associations, incorporations, private, public and municipal and bodies politic, and with the government of the United States, and with any state or territory, colony or district thereof.

5. This corporation shall have the power to borrow or raise money without limit as to amount by the issue of or upon warrants, bonds, debentures or other negotiable or transferable instruments or other obligations of the corporation, and to secure the payment of such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon assignment of or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property of the corporation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter acquired.

6. To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated, or which at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection

or benefit of this corporation.

THIRD: That the term for which this corporation is to exist is perpetual.

FOURTH: That the location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation shall be Idaho Falls, Idaho.

FIFTH: That the amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be \$25,000, to consist of 2500 shares of common stock of the par value of \$10 each.

SIXTH: That the following are the names and post office addresses of each of the incorporators, and the number of shares subscribed by each are set opposite the respective name of each incorporator, to-wit:
